A firebreak (east-west-trending white swath) was bulldozed through the project area in mid-December 2017 in advance of the fire. All vegetation within this polygon, including scrub oaks and the canyon live oak, was removed and a 100-foot long reach of a tributary of McDonald Canyon Creek (pale blue line) was filled with soil. Bush Mallow Shrubland (PC3-light blue) and Rig-gut Brome Semi-Natural Herbaceous Stand (PC2-uncolored areas) burned in the Thomas Fire in December 2017.
