







California's Top 10 Agricultural Commodities


California's agricultural abundance includes more than 400 commodities. Over a third of the country's vegetables and nearly three-quarters of the country's fruits and nuts are grown in California. California's top 10 valued commodities for the 2022 crop year are:¹

- Dairy Products, Milk —\$10.40 billion
- Grapes —\$5.54 billion
- Cattle and Calves —\$3.63 billion
- Almonds —\$3.52 billion
- Lettuce —\$3.15 billion
- Strawberries —\$2.68 billion
- Pistachios —\$1.86 billion
- Broilers —\$1.59 billion
- Tomatoes —\$1.46 billion
- Carrots —\$1.11 billion


NATIONAL CHILD COUNTS FOR NATIONAL PROFILE

The table shows the National unduplicated count of eligible migratory children age birth through 21 as determined on 12/24/2022. It should be noted that due to the difference in logic used to determine inclusion and eligibility, the count of eligible migratory children will not be equal to the sum of the Category 1 and Age Birth through 2 children.




TOTAL MEP POPULATION (TABLE 1)





CHILDREN WITH QUALIFYING ARRIVAL DATES (QADS) DURING THE PERFORMANCE PERIOD (TABLE 5A)

Below shows an unduplicated count of children by State who made an interstate or intrastate move that generated a QAD in the performance period as reported by either the Move To or Move From State. Regardless of the amount of moves a child made within a State, the child will only be counted once per State. When a State reports a move where they are not the Move To or Move From State, the QAD is not counted in this table.







Migrant Education



In 1966 Congress responded to the unmet academic needs of the children of the growing farm worker population by authorizing the creation of the Office of Migrant Education. To help migratory children overcome educational disruption, cultural and language barriers, social isolation, various health-related problems, and other factors that inhibit the ability of such children to succeed in school.

Migrant Education



Funded by the federal government created in 1966 authorized by Part C of Title 1 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act as amended by the Law of Success for all students.

Local Student Stories





In the evening the sisters try to do their homework online and via email without the benefit of any direct instruction that took place digitally during the day.

Students receive transportation to ensure access to services; such as Saturday and summer school, field trips, and other approved events.




Leadership Opportunities 6-12








Economic Hardship by Race




Figure 10: Percent with no health insurance by immigration status & age, Santa Barbara and Ventura Counties, 2018






Figure 4: Median wage by educational attainment, race, and gender, Ventura County, 2018


