The proposed net impact to County of Ventura agencies is an increase of 3.1% for rates and allocations

# Property Tax Replacement

## GOALS

- ◆ Update mainframe- based property tax system to a modern technology platform that is more supportable and more secure. Includes citizen portal and other new features.
- ◆ Estimated total cost: \$18 M

# Criminal Justice System Modernization (VCIJIS 2.0)

## GOALS

- ◆ Migrate and update existing VCIJIS system to a new supportable platform and increase operational efficiencies; integration to other state of the art law enforcement technologies and meet legal mandates.
- ◆ Estimated Cost: \$44 M



# Regional Radio

## GOALS

- ◆ Create a Countywide digital radio system for public safety, County and city operations, educational operations, and others.
- ◆ Estimated total cost: \$36 M (not including radios)



# Broadband

## GOALS

- ◆ Deliver the internet to underserved and disadvantaged neighborhoods
- ◆ Improve availability and quality of telework, telemedicine, and distance learning
- ◆ Support economic development
- ◆ Estimated total cost: \$20-25 million (may be grant funded)
