Administration

- County of Ventura, Supervisorial District No. 5
- The County of Ventura Board of Supervisors is the governing body.
- The Water and Sanitation Department is responsible for the administration, operation, and maintenance of the sewer collection system.

Overview

- Formed December 1, 2005, for the purpose of constructing, operating, and maintaining a sewer collection system for the unincorporated area of El Rio, Strickland Tract and Juvenile Justice Complex.
- Sewer service area is approximately 850 acres
- Lies within the El Rio Forebay
- Bounded by U.S. Highway 101 on the south, South Park Road on the west, Rose Avenue on the east, and Strickland Drive on the north.
- Sewer collection system completed July 2011
- Population served: 4,403
- Sewage is discharged to the City of Oxnard for wastewater treatment and disposal.


