Subject: **Adoption of a Resolution Listing Projects to be funded by the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account for Fiscal Year 2025-26; All Supervisorial Districts.**

Recommendations:

Adopt the attached Resolution listing projects to be funded by the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account for Fiscal Year 2025-26.

Fiscal Impact(s):

There are no additional costs associated with this Board action. Funding for specific projects will be addressed with the Board approval of each project.

Discussion:

Senate Bill 1 created the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Act) and a newly formed Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) to address the significant multimodal transportation funding shortfalls statewide. The Streets and Highways Code § 2034(a)(1) (Act) includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our County are aware of the projects proposed for funding and which projects have been completed each fiscal year.

The Act requires the County to submit to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) each fiscal year, a list of projects proposed to receive RMRA funding. The Commission requires that the list be included in a resolution, adopted at a regular public meeting. The list must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement. The project list does not limit the flexibility of the County to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities so long as the projects are consistent with the Act's priorities.



The County is estimated to receive \$17,101,273 in RMRA funding in fiscal year 2025-26. This will be the ninth year in which the County is receiving RMRA funding. This will enable us to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects to maintain our existing infrastructure in good repair.

The projects for fiscal year 2025-26 proposed to be funded by RMRA – listed in the attached proposed Resolution – were approved by your Board in the Multi-Year Pavement Plan, except for the last item, which is routine road maintenance.


