Dear Clerk and Board Members,

As a former candidate and someone with personal experience—my own son’s vote not being counted in 2022—I initially thought this could have been an isolated issue. We have a problem with Mass mail in voting with ZERO chain of custody. On Dominion, after hearing from experts and listening to bipartisan concerns dating back to 2015, it’s clear that problems with Dominion voting systems have been noted on all sides.

I was disappointed by what I felt was a lack of transparency in the board’s recent decisions, particularly with Kelly Long, whom I personally helped secure a Republican endorsement. This recent action seems to disregard the voices of the very voters who placed her in office. Additionally, I heard Matt Levere’s radio segment, where he suggested that concerns over voter integrity are from "extremist." To label serious questions from informed individuals like Deb Cohen EXPERT Data Analysis in such a way is dismissive and damaging to the democratic process.

Another major issue remains with mass mail-in voting. Through canvassing efforts, teams encountered multiple residents who believed they had voted by mail in the past 2 elections, only to discover post-election that their votes were never recorded. If elected officials do not take voter integrity concerns seriously, public trust will continue to erode. Voting is a privilege and should be safeguarded with rigorous oversight.

A nine-year extension without thorough public discourse and citizen input is a disservice to the people of this county. After discussing what happened at the last board meeting, I now represent over 151,000 constituents who share deep dissatisfaction with recent board actions.

We must do better to restore and maintain public confidence in our elections.
