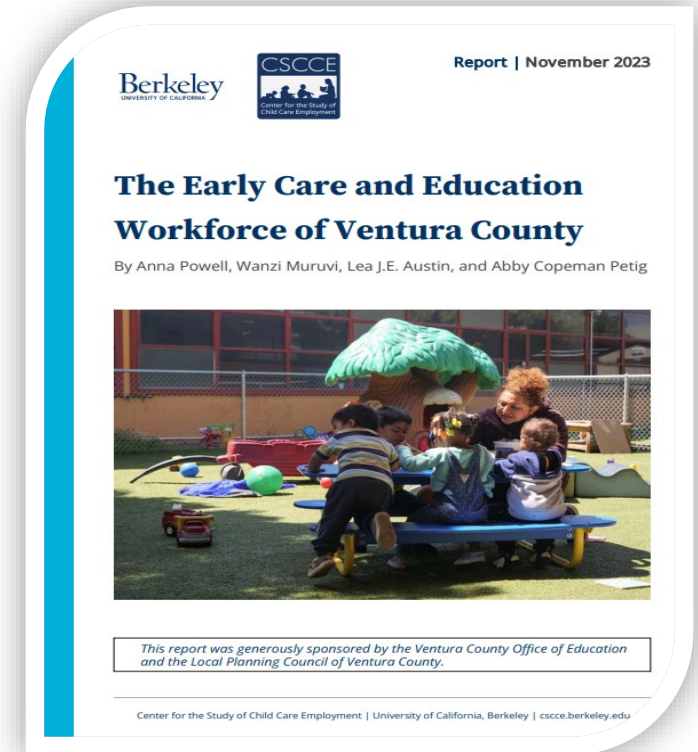
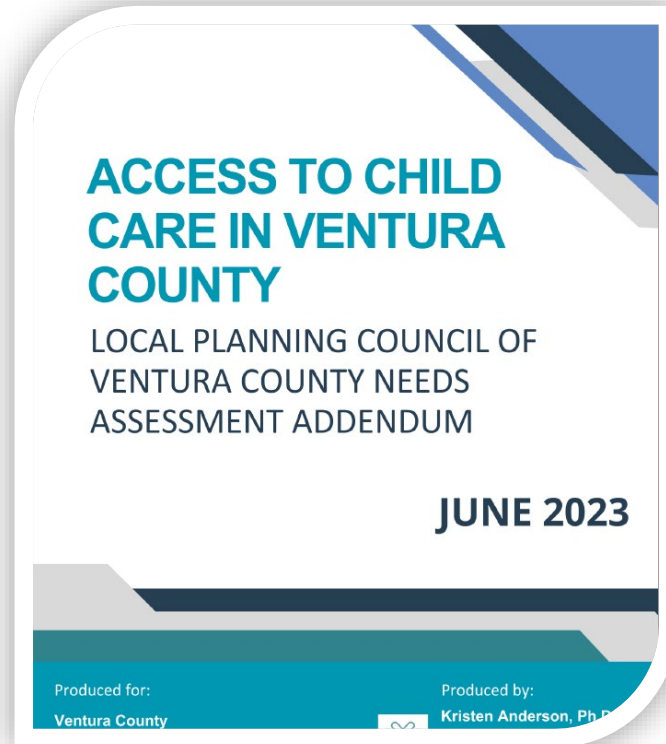
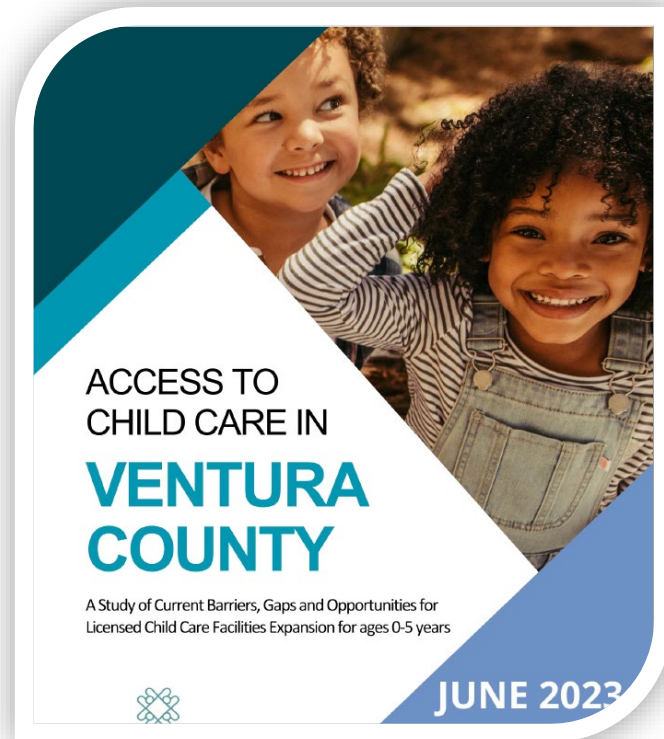

LPC-Sponsored Reports



Universal PreKindergarten (UPK)

is an expansion of the state's current mixed delivery system that meets the early learning and care needs of 3 and 4-year-old children and their families. It includes all existing state and federal early learning, private childcare, and extended learning program.

Early Learning

- Programs are required to include educational activities
- Staff have health and safety training plus college coursework in early childhood development
- Programs are required to utilize a curriculum
- Facilities meet Title 5 and/or Title 22 health and safety standards

Head Start

General Childcare (CCTR)

Expanded Learning

- Programs must include enrichment activities
- Staff meet minimum district instructional aide requirements
- Operates during non-school hours, summer, and intercessions

Expanded Learning Opportunities (ELO)

After School Education & Safety (ASES)

21st Century Community Learning Centers (21CCLC)

Child Care

- Programs are not required to include educational activities
- Staff have health and safety training and may have some college coursework
- Facilities meet Title 22 health and safety standards

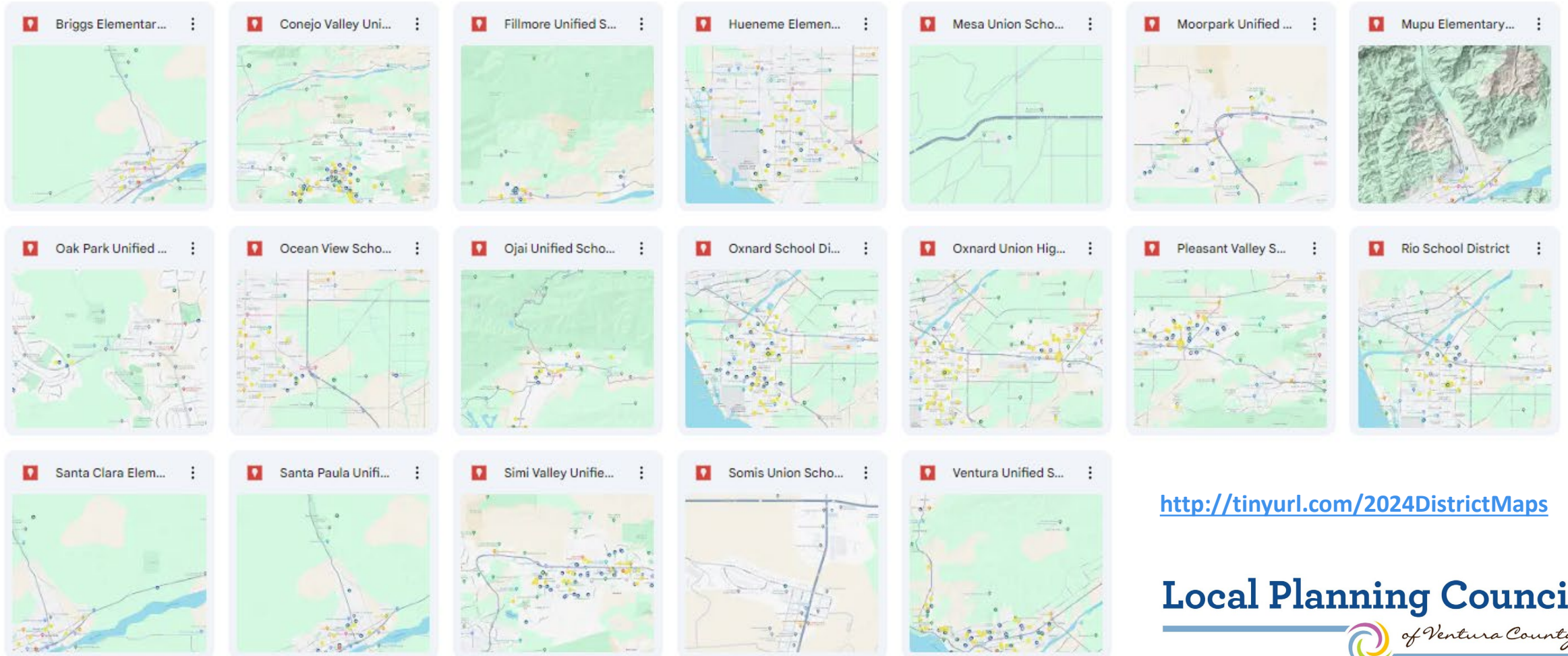
