**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
DESIGNATING THE VENTURA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AS A COUNTY AGENCY
AND PRE-TRIAL DETENTION FACILITY AND TODD ROAD JAIL FACILITY AS
AUTHORIZED TREATMENT FACILITIES FOR ADMINISTERING NON-EMERGENCY
INVOLUNTARY PSYCHIATRIC MEDICATION TO INCARCERATED PERSONS UNDER
PENAL CODE SECTION 2603**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2603 of the Penal Code, a county department of mental health or other designated county department may administer involuntary psychiatric medication on a non-emergency basis to incarcerated persons subject to conditions set forth in Section 2603; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to designate the Ventura County Sheriff's Office as a county agency authorized to administer, through its contracted medical provider, involuntary psychiatric medication to incarcerated persons under Penal Code Section 2603; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to designate the County of Ventura's Pre-Trial Detention Facility and Todd Road Jail Facility as authorized treatment facilities for administering non-emergency involuntary psychiatric medication to incarcerated persons under Penal Code section 2603;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ventura County Sheriff's Office is hereby designated as a County agency authorized, through its contracted medical provider, to administer involuntary psychiatric medication on a non-emergency basis to incarcerated persons in the County of Ventura's Pre-Trial Detention and Todd Road Jail Facilities subject to Penal Code section 2603.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Ventura's Pre-Trial Detention and Todd Road Jail Facilities are hereby designated as authorized treatment facilities for administering non-emergency involuntary psychiatric medication to incarcerated persons pursuant to Penal Code section 2603.

Upon motion of Supervisor Long, seconded by Supervisor Lavee, and duly carried, the Board hereby approves and adopts this resolution on the 11th day of February 2025.
