SUBJECT: Approval of, and Authorization for the Purchasing Agent or Designee to Sign, Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. 8999 with Maxim Healthcare Services Holdings, Inc. dba Amergis Healthcare Staffing, Inc. (Amergis), for Temporary Staffing Services; Ratification of the Health Care Agency's Authorization of Amergis to Provide Services Under the Terms of the Amendment in Anticipation of Your Board's Approval.

RECOMMENDATION:

That your Board approve, and authorize the Purchasing Agent or designee to sign, amendment No. 3 to contract No. 8999 with Maxim Healthcare Services Holdings, Inc. dba Amergis Healthcare Staffing, Inc. (Amergis), for temporary staffing services, and ratify HCA's authorization of Amergis to provide services in anticipation of your Board's approval of this amendment.

The contractor changed its name while your Board was not in session.

DISCUSSION:

Amergis has been a trusted provider of temporary staffing services for the Healthcare Agency since 2003, demonstrating a strong commitment to supporting our community. Over the past several years, Amergis has played a crucial role in furnishing temporary

staff to bolster the County's COVID-19 hotline and provided invaluable support within the Public Health Department and Ambulatory Care clinics during the pandemic.

The proposed amendment updates the name of the contractor from Maxim Healthcare Services Holdings, Inc. dba Maxim Healthcare Services Holdings, Inc. to Maxim Healthcare Services Holdings, Inc. dba Amergis Healthcare Staffing, Inc. This amendment is necessary to reflect the contractor's rebranding and new operating name, while the corporate entity remains unchanged. There is no fiscal impact associated with this amendment.
