- 265,755 people visited the libraries in person
 - 41,582 reference questions answered
 - 866,322 items checked out
 - 1,735 programs
 - 32,794 program attendees
 - 191,922 wireless sessions
 - 21,324 uses of public internet computers
 - 9,060 STEAM Kits given out to children
 - Over 1 million minutes read by children during Summer Reading 2023
