



HONORING  
JUNETEENTH INDEPENDENCE DAY  
JUNE 19, 2025

**WHEREAS**, ON JANUARY 1, 1863, PRESIDENT ABRAHAM LINCOLN ISSUED THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION, SETTING IN MOTION THE END OF SLAVERY IN THE UNITED STATES; AND

**WHEREAS**, ON JUNE 19, 1865, UNION SOLDIERS MADE THE ANNOUNCEMENT IN GALVESTON, TEXAS THAT THE REMAINING ENSLAVED AFRICAN AMERICANS IN THE UNITED STATES WERE FREED; AND

**WHEREAS**, JUNETEENTH RECOGNIZES THE EMANCIPATION OF THE LAST REMAINING ENSLAVED AFRICAN AMERICANS AND COMMEMORATES THE END OF SLAVERY IN THE UNITED STATES AND IS REFERRED TO AS FREEDOM DAY AND EMANCIPATION DAY; AND

**WHEREAS**, WHILE AFRICAN AMERICANS HAVE BEEN AFFORDED LEGAL FREEDOMS, OVERT INSTITUTIONAL/SYSTEMIC RACISM PERSISTS AND IS MANIFESTED IN DISPARITIES REGARDING WEALTH, INCOME, CRIMINAL JUSTICE, EMPLOYMENT, HOUSING, HEALTH CARE, POLITICAL POWER, EDUCATION, AND OPPORTUNITY AMONG OTHER FACTORS; AND

**WHEREAS**, WE KNOW VENTURA COUNTY CITIZENS VALUE OUR DIVERSITY, CULTURES AND HERITAGE, AND WE STAND IN SOLIDARITY AGAINST RACISM WHEREVER IT IS FOUND, AND FOR RESTORATIVE JUSTICE AND PROTECTION OF AFRICAN AMERICANS TO THRIVE AND CONTRIBUTE THEIR INHERENT VALUE, SKILLS, GIFTS, AND ABILITIES TO OUR LOCAL COMMUNITIES AND ECONOMY; AND

**WHEREAS**, FOR 34 YEARS, JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION OF VENTURA COUNTY ORGANIZATION, ALONG WITH OTHER COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS, HAVE HELD THE ANNUAL COMMUNITY CELEBRATION OF JUNETEENTH AND FREEDOM FROM ENSLAVEMENT WHILE UPLIFTING AND BRINGING CULTURAL AWARENESS; AND

**WHEREAS**, ON A LARGER SCALE, THE ANNUAL TRADITION OF CELEBRATING JUNETEENTH REMINDS US ALL OF THE PRECIOUS PROMISES OF FREEDOM, EQUALITY, AND OPPORTUNITY WHICH ARE AT THE CORE OF THE AMERICAN DREAM.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, THAT THE VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZES JUNE 19, 2025 AS JUNETEENTH NATIONAL INDEPENDENCE DAY IN VENTURA COUNTY, AND HONORS IT AS A DAY TO ALWAYS REMEMBER OUR NATION'S PAST AND OUR CONTINUING EFFORT TOWARD ENSURING FREEDOM, EQUALITY, AND JUSTICE FOR EVERY AMERICAN, AND TAKES GREAT PLEASURE IN HONORING THE JUNETEENTH COMMITTEE.
