Dear Ventura County Board of Supervisors,

I am writing to you with concerns about voter registration in the upcoming elections. Transparency needs to be improved from current levels.

What process will the Registrar of Voters (RoV) be using to clean and maintain the current voter rolls?

Monthly reports on these processes along with weekly reports during 30 days prior to election should be available to ensure transparency.

How will the RoV check the validity of late or same day (Election Day) registrations?

The voters will be given provisional ballot which would require a validation. What process will be used for this? Are any of the registrations denied? Is there any public reporting on this?

There should be methods of verifying voter registration before mailing out ballots to everyone. There are reports of people receiving more than one ballot with some for other people not residing at their address.

I'm urging the county Board of Supervisors to add an agenda item to discuss these important issues to increase transparency in our election process in Ventura county.
