

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE ORGANIZATIONAL PROVIDER AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF VENTURA AND AMADA ENTERPRISES, INC., DBA,
VIEW HEIGHTS CONVALESCENT HOSPITAL**

This "Second Amendment" to the Agreement for Adult Residential Treatment Services, which became effective July 1, 2023, is made and entered into by and between the **COUNTY OF VENTURA**, acting through its Behavioral Health Department (VCBH), a primary service provider, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and **AMADA ENTERPRISES, INC. (DBA VIEW HEIGHTS CONVALESCENT HOSPITAL)**, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR".

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree that the Agreement, is amended as follows:

- I. Effective with respect to the service period commencing July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, Exhibit "B" (PAYMENT TERMS), Subsection A of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:
 - A. COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Exhibit "B" (PAYMENT TERMS) for CONTRACTOR's satisfactory performance or provision of the services and work described in Exhibit "A" (PROGRAM DESCRIPTION). Except otherwise expressly provided in this Agreement, the maximum total sum of all payments made by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR for services and work performed or provided under this Agreement shall not exceed \$4,475,000 for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. Of this amount \$15,526 shall be for payment for services rendered in FY 2022-23.
- II. Except for the modifications described herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement, as previously amended, shall remain in effect.
- III. This Second Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
- IV. The parties hereto agree that this Second Amendment may be transmitted and signed by electronic or digital means by either/any or both/all parties and that such signatures shall have the same force and effect as original signatures, in accordance with California Government Code Section 16.5 and California Civil Code Section 1633.7.
