WHEREAS, relationships with caring mentors offer youth consistent role models, valuable encouragement, motivation, hope and support to guide them toward making positive choices; and

WHEREAS, mentoring programs and collaboratives throughout California are committed to increasing the number of quality mentors, especially in marginalized communities; and

WHEREAS, partnerships between businesses, educational institutions and mentor programs are an effective way for businesses to support youth within the community; and

WHEREAS, mentoring before, during, and after school has become an effective strategy used by schools to increase student attendance and academic performance; and

WHEREAS, hundreds of Ventura County youth are waiting for mentors.




