Approval of, and Authorization for the Purchasing Agent or Designee to Sign, Amendment No. 12 to the Agreement for Nephrology / Dialysis Services with Haemo-Stat, Inc. dba Haemo-Stat Acute Services for Inpatient Dialysis Services, Effective January 1, 2024, Extending the Contract by Three Months, through March 31, 2024, and Increasing the Not-to-Exceed Amount by \$500,000 from \$3,650,000 to \$4,150,000 for the Period of January 1, 2021 through March 31, 2024.

That your Board approve, and authorize the Purchasing Agent or designee to sign, amendment No. 12 to the agreement for nephrology / dialysis services with Haemo-Stat, Inc. dba Haemo-Stat Acute Services (Haemo-Stat) for inpatient dialysis services, effective January 1, 2024, extending the contract through March 31, 2024, and increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$500,000 from \$3,650,000 to \$4,150,000 for the period of January 1, 2021 through March 31, 2024.

STRATEGIC PLAN PRIORITY:

The item presented in this Board letter supports the Healthy, Safe, and Resilient Communities strategic priority of the County Strategic Plan as it is designed to meet the goal of providing access to quality healthcare required for our community to thrive.

DISCUSSION:

Haemo-Stat provides inpatient dialysis services for Ventura County Medical Center (VCMC) and Santa Paula Hospital (SPH). The services provided by Haemo-Stat are vital to VCMC and SPH patients. The attached proposed amendment extends the term of the contract through March 31, 2024, and increases the not-to-exceed amount by \$500,000 to \$4,150,000 for the period from January 1, 2021 through March 31, 2024, allowing the Health Care Agency and Haemo-Stat time to complete negotiations on a new contract, which is expected to be effective April 1, 2024.
