

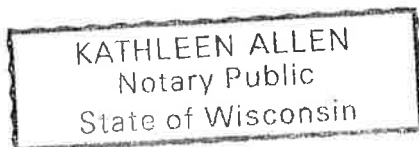

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2002
the Board of Supervisors of
the County of Ventura
("Board") ordered the
formation of and levied the
first assessment within the
Oak View School
Preservation and
Maintenance District
("District") pursuant to the
provisions of Article XIII D
of the California Constitution
(Proposition 218), and the
Landscaping and Lighting
Act of 1972 (the "Act"),
codified in Part 2 of Division
15 of the California Streets
and Highways Code
(commencing with Section
22500 thereof); and
WHEREAS, on May 14, 2024,
the Board adopted a
Resolution of Intention to
Levy Assessments for Fiscal
Year (FY) 2024-25,
Preliminarily Approve the
Engineer's Report, and
Provide for Notice of
Hearing of the levy of
assessment for the District;
and
WHEREAS, notice of the
hearing was given as
required by law, and the
hearing was held before the
Board on June 4, 2024, at the
Board of Supervisors
Hearing Room in the County
of Ventura Government
Center, Hall of
Administration, located at
800 South Victoria Avenue,
Ventura, California, on the
question of the levy of the
assessment; and
WHEREAS, at the hearing
all persons interested and
desiring to be heard were
given an opportunity to be
heard, and all oral
statements and all written
protests pertaining to the
levy were fully heard and
considered by this Board;
and
WHEREAS, the Engineer's
Report was also duly
considered by the Board and
found to be sufficient;
NOW, THEREFORE, the
Board hereby finds,
determines and orders that:
1. The public interest,
convenience, and necessity
require that the levy be
made.
2. The Engineer's Report,
including the plans and
specifications, estimate of
the costs and expenses, the
diagram, and the
assessment, including any
modifications or revisions,
which is attached as Exhibit
1 to the June 4, 2024 Board
letter, is approved and
confirmed.
3. Based on the oral and
documentary evidence,
including the Engineer's
Report, offered and received
at the hearing, this Board
finds and determines that:
(a) each of the lots and
parcels of land within the
District boundaries will be
specially benefited by the
improvements and
maintenance of the
improvements at least in the
amount of, if not more than
the amount of, the
assessment apportioned
against the lots and parcels
of land, respectively, and (b)

there is substantial evidence to support, and the weight of the evidence preponderates in favor of, this finding and determination as to special benefits.

4. The diagram of the District as contained in the Engineer's Report for FY 2024-25 is hereby approved, and confirmed.

5. The assessment as established in the Engineer's Report for FY 2024-25 is hereby approved, confirmed and levied.

6. Immediately upon the adoption of this resolution, but in no event later than the second Monday in August following such adoption, the Board shall file a certified copy of this resolution with the Auditor of the County of Ventura. Upon such filing, the County Auditor shall enter on the County assessment roll opposite each lot or parcel of land the amount of assessment thereupon as shown in the assessment. The assessments shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as County taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of County taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the assessments.

7. After deduction of costs incurred by the County in administering and collecting the assessments, the net amount of the assessments shall be deposited in the County

Treasury to the credit of the improvement fund previously established under the distinctive designation of the "Oak View School Preservation and Maintenance District."

Moneys in the improvement fund shall be expended only for the maintenance, servicing, construction, and/or installation of the improvements.

8. This assessment was established and levied in conformance with Proposition 218.

Upon motion of Supervisor , seconded by Supervisor and duly carried, the Board hereby adopts the foregoing on June 4, 2024.
