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## INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the Market Area Rate Study (MARS) is to establish the calendar year 2025 maximum allowable gate rate (i.e., tipping fee) at the Simi Valley Landfill & Recycling Center (SVLRC), located just north of both the 118 Freeway and the City of Simi Valley, in the unincorporated area of Ventura County, as shown on Exhibit A.

## BACKGROUND

The SVLRC is wholly owned and operated by Waste Management of California, Inc. (WM). On March 20, 2012, the Ventura County Board of Supervisors approved the *Amended and Restated Agreement for the Operation and Closure of the Simi Valley Landfill and Recycling Center* (Agreement) between WM and the County of Ventura. One component of this Agreement outlines the use of an annual MARS to establish the maximum allowable gate rate at the SVLRC for the upcoming calendar year utilizing the methodology described below.

## METHODOLOGY

The following tasks were completed in preparation for the 2024 MARS:

**Task 1.** Pursuant to Section 4.3.3. of the Agreement, a list of permitted and active MSW landfills was created from the Solid Waste Information System (SWIS) database of the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle). The list was pared to include only landfills located within each applicable county of the designated geographical area currently accepting municipal solid waste (MSW) from the general public; for example, landfills serving only their private owners or military bases are excluded. The remaining 27 landfills, as shown in Exhibit C, is referred to as the Market Index. Specific exclusions are detailed in the accompanying notes to Table 2.

Since the 2023 MARS, no new landfills were opened, and no existing landfills were closed; therefore, the number of landfills in the Market Index remains at 27.

**Task 2.** The Market Index was reviewed to determine the total number of publicly owned or operated and WM owned or operated landfills. The California Secretary of State database was utilized to verify information about WM's subsidiaries. The percentages of publicly owned or operated and WM owned or operated landfills were calculated and compared to threshold levels as stated in the Agreement. The percentages remain below threshold levels; therefore, no adjustment of the Market Index is needed.

**Task 3.** For the purposes of the study, the Posted Gate Rate is the standard rate for disposal of MSW on a per ton basis, including taxes and fees, effective July 1, 2024. Rates for special wastes, hard-to-handle loads, and similar classifications are not within the scope of the study.

For each landfill, rate sheets and additional documentation were requested from the landfill operator by e-mail where available, and by website or telephone as necessary. In the event that the effective date was not clear on the posted rate sheet, the landfill operator was contacted by e-mail or telephone for verification.

**Task 4.** The information obtained in Tasks 1, 2, and 3 is presented in this report. Table 1 provides a brief summary of the calculated Mean Market Rate, County Surcharge, In and Out-of-County Variances,

and maximum gate rates for the SVLRC. Table 2 summarizes the ownership information and posted gate rates for each Market Index landfill. Notes following Table 2 provide additional details. The current SVLRC rate schedule is provided as Exhibit B, with the collected rate documentation for the remaining Market Index landfills included as Exhibit D.

## 2024 MEAN MARKET RATE

To determine the Mean Market Rate, the posted gate rates of each of the 27 landfills within the study area were obtained or calculated from documentation provided by the landfill operator (Exhibit D) and used to calculate the mean. The Posted Gate Rates range from \$46.63 per ton to \$131.97 per ton, as shown in Table 2.

The Mean Market Rate for 2024 is \$81.82 per ton, an increase of 7.56% (\$5.75 per ton) relative to the 2023 Mean Market Rate of \$76.07 per ton.

Based upon the Mean Market Rate determination in this study, the maximum allowable gate rate at the SVLRC for MSW originating in Ventura County, or outside of California, for calendar year 2025 is \$90.00, calculated from the sum total of the Mean Market Rate (\$81.82) plus the In-County Market Rate Variance of \$4.09 per ton (5% of the Mean Market Rate) and the County Surcharge of \$4.09 per ton (also 5% of the Mean Market Rate).

The maximum allowable gate rate at the SVLRC for MSW originating outside of Ventura County, and within California, for calendar year 2025 is \$94.09, calculated from the sum total of the Mean Market Rate (\$81.82) plus the Out-of-County Market Rate Variance of \$8.18 per ton (10% of the Mean Market Rate) and the County Surcharge of \$4.09 per ton (5% of the Mean Market Rate).

For all other 2025 rates at the SVLRC, this Study has no effect as those rates are established by a separate process in which WM submits an Annual Report to the County no later than September 1 of each year. Within the context of the Annual Report, WM may propose changes to any rate, other than the maximum allowable gate rate, at the SVLRC for calendar year 2025. Upon receipt of the Annual Report, the County must review all proposed rates no later than October 1 and respond to WM via a rate approval letter no later than October 15.

**Table 2 Accompanying Notes**

1. The Inventory of Active MSW Landfills within the designated geographical area as of July 1, 2024, except those that serve only their private owners, military bases, and as explained in Note (2).
2. California Street Landfill is an active MSW landfill as of July 1, 2024, and is within the designated geographical area; however, the site has not been included in the Inventory since its inception in 2002 because there is no Posted Gate Rate. The landfill is located in, and is operated by, the City of Redlands, and accepts waste only from their own collection vehicles. Because no other waste is imported or accepted from the public or other haulers, there is no Posted Gate Rate.
3. No new landfills have been added to this study and none of the existing landfills have been closed or removed. The number of landfills in the Market Index remains at 27.
4. Whether a facility is publicly owned or operated is determined by information obtained from the CalRecycle SWIS website and California Secretary of State online database. If the facility is owned, operated, or both, by a public entity, then "Yes" is shown; if the facility is neither owned nor operated by a public entity, then "No" is shown.
5. Whether a facility is owned or operated by WM is determined by information obtained from the CalRecycle SWIS website and California Secretary of State online database. If the facility is owned, operated, or both, by WM, then "Yes" is shown. If the facility is neither owned nor operated by WM, then "No" is shown.
6. For purposes of this study, the Posted Gate Rate is the standard gate rate for disposal of MSW on a per ton basis, including all taxes and fees. For each landfill, rate sheets or similar documentation were obtained from the landfill operator by fax, website, or e-mail. When information on websites was not clear, with regard to the effective date, the operator was contacted by telephone or e-mail to verify rates shown on the website were correct for July 1, 2024. Refer to additional notes for special cases.
7. For Antelope Valley Public Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate is \$108.99 per ton for "Solid Waste - MSW", plus a 7.19% Energy Surcharge derived from averaging the weekly WM Disposal Energy Surcharge percentages over the previous fiscal year.
8. For Burbank Landfill No. 3, the rate is the fee charged to internal City departments and the school district only. The landfill is not open to the public. Rates were confirmed by City of Burbank staff via e-mail, dated June 17, 2024.
9. For Chicago Grade Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate is \$69.00, confirmed by the facility Site Manager via e-mail, dated June 17, 2024.
10. For Cold Canyon Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate is \$92.00, confirmed by facility administration via e-mail, dated June 3, 2024.
11. For Lancaster Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate is \$113.94 per ton for "Solid Waste - MSW", plus a 7.19% Energy Surcharge derived from averaging the weekly WM Disposal Energy Surcharge percentages over the previous fiscal year.

12. For the City of Lompoc Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate is \$105.00, inclusive of a “State Recycle Fee” and a “County Inspection Fee”, confirmed by City of Lompoc staff via e-mail, dated June 3, 2024.
13. For Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill and San Timoteo Sanitary Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate remains \$48.80 plus a “Comprehensive Disposal Onsite Diversion Program Fee” of \$12 per ton and a “Perchlorate Fee” of \$.69 per ton. This data was confirmed by San Bernardino County Solid Waste Programs Administration via e-mail, dated June 6, 2024.
14. For Otay Landfill and Sycamore Landfills, the Posted Gate Rate remains unchanged at \$105.00 per ton for “General Refuse”, as confirmed by gatehouse personnel, plus an average 9.98% Fuel Recovery Fee (FRF) derived from the monthly FRFs over the previous fiscal year. An Environmental Fee per load, also indicated on the rate sheet, is not included because that fee is not applied on a “per ton” basis.
15. For Paso Robles Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate will remain unchanged at \$63.00 per ton, confirmed by City of Paso Robles Solid Waste & Recycling program management via e-mail, dated June 3, 2024.
16. For Santa Maria Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate is \$90.00 per ton, confirmed by the public rate sheet available on their website.
17. For Savage Canyon Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate will be \$59.31, confirmed by City of Whittier Public Works via e-mail, dated June 3, 2024.
18. For Sunshine Canyon Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate, effective July 1, 2024, will be \$120 per ton for “Municipal Waste / Construction & Demolition” plus an average 9.98% Fuel Recovery Fee (FRF) derived from the monthly FRFs over the previous fiscal year. The base rate is documented in a rate sheet received from facility staff via e-mail on June 24, 2024. An Environmental Fee per load, also indicated on the rate sheet, is not included because that fee is not applied on a “per ton” basis.
19. For Tajiguas Sanitary Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate will be \$121.00 per ton, effective July 1, 2024, confirmed by County of Santa Barbara staff via e-mail, dated June 18, 2024.
20. For the Toland Road Landfill, the new Posted Gate Rate, effective July 1, 2024, is \$46.63, confirmed by VRSD staff via e-mail, dated June 25, 2024.
21. For the West Miramar Landfill, the Posted Gate Rate will be \$101.00 per ton, confirmed by City of San Diego, Environmental Services Department staff via e-mail, dated June 24, 2024, as well as the public rate sheet available on their website.

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### Recyclable Material Definitions

**Clean Asphalt and Concrete:** Any combination of rock, concrete, gravel, brick, asphalt, or asphalt grindings which is less than 24 inches in any two (2) dimensions. Loads containing debris exceeding this size limitation will be charged as Municipal Solid Waste (MSW). Loads greater than six (6) feet in any dimension may be assessed an additional hard-to-handle fee. Concrete debris should have minimal re-bar protruding from the individual pieces of concrete. Trash, excessive metal, wood, roots or grass contaminants are not accepted. *Loads with these contaminants will be charged as MSW.*

**Clean Dirt:** Granular soil such as clay, sand, or silt that breaks apart when handled by light duty construction equipment; such as a small backhoe or skip loader. No trash, metal, or wood is accepted and less than 10% root and/or grass contamination. *Loads with these contaminants will be charged as municipal solid waste (MSW).*


**Construction and Demolition (C&D):** Combination of materials derived from construction activities; such as, lumber, drywall, glass, metal, roofing material, tile, carpeting, window coverings, plastic pipe, concrete, asphalt, air ducting, appliances, furnishings and fixtures, plant material, cardboard packaging, and tools. All materials must be free of lead paint, chemical additives, and asbestos and contain less than 1% putrescible waste. Demolition projects must provide a demolition permit. **C&D Certification available for an additional fee per ton.**

**Greenwaste and Woodwaste:** Any combination of clean wood, dimensional lumber (no painted or treated wood), grass, branches, leaves and other plant matter. Minimal roots and soil content allowed. Trash, recyclables, palm fronds, yucca plants, and ice plants are not accepted. *Loads with these contaminants will be charged as MSW.*

**Food Waste:** Material resulting from the processing, storage, preparation, cooking, handling, or consumption of food. This type includes material from industrial, commercial, or residential sources such as meat scraps, dairy products, eggshells, fruit or vegetable peels, and other food items from homes, stores, and restaurants.


