
# Status of Current Paving Plan



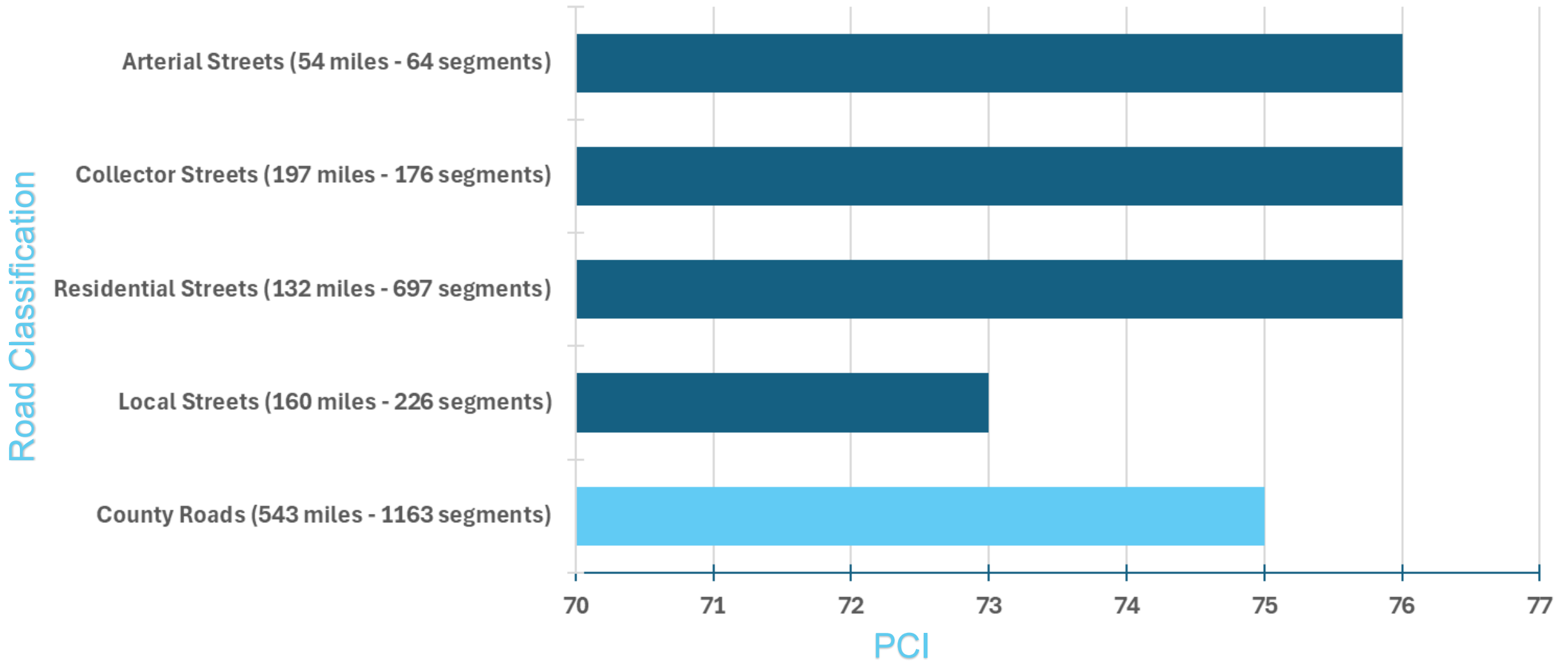

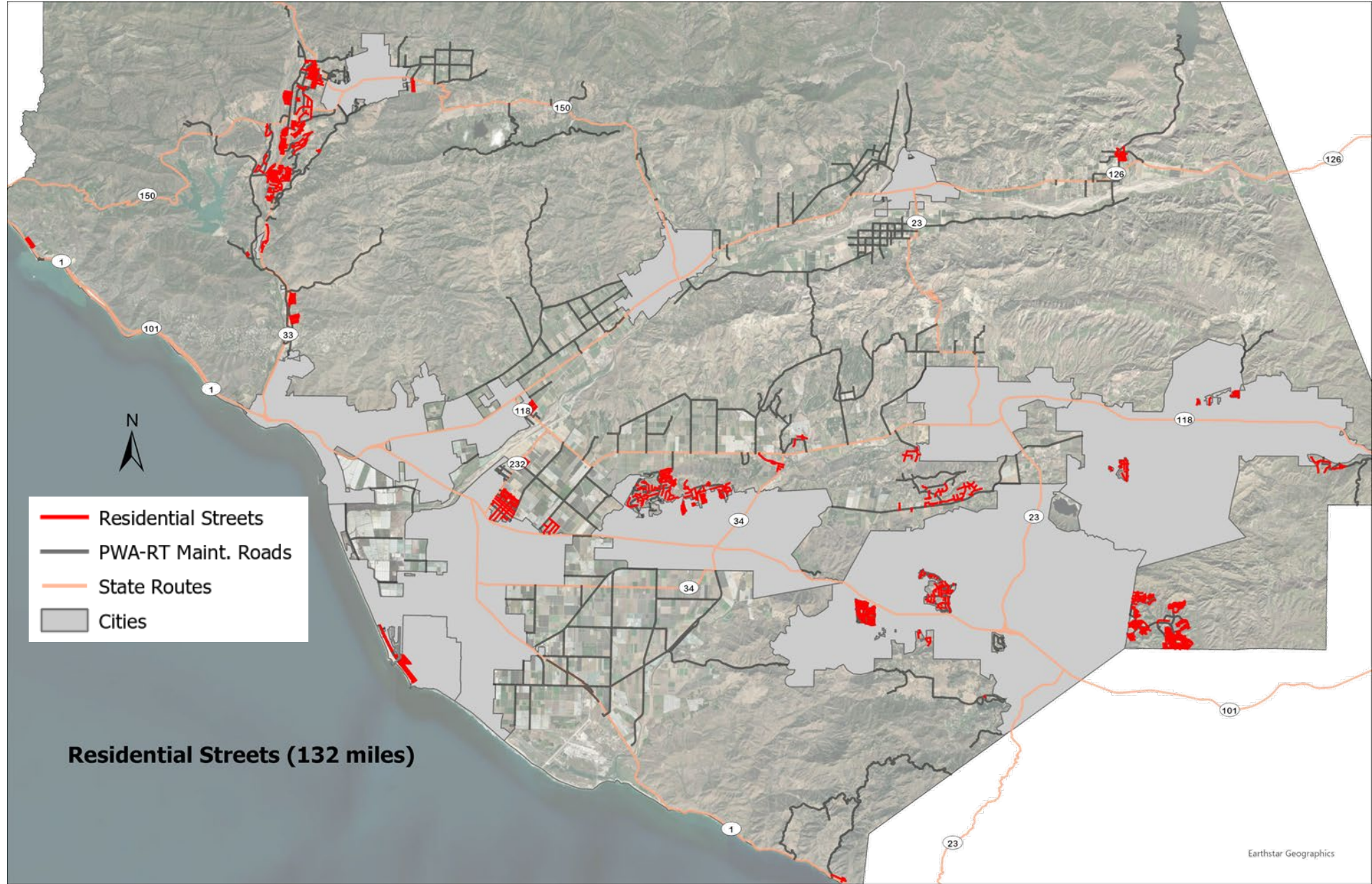

# Map of Residential Streets

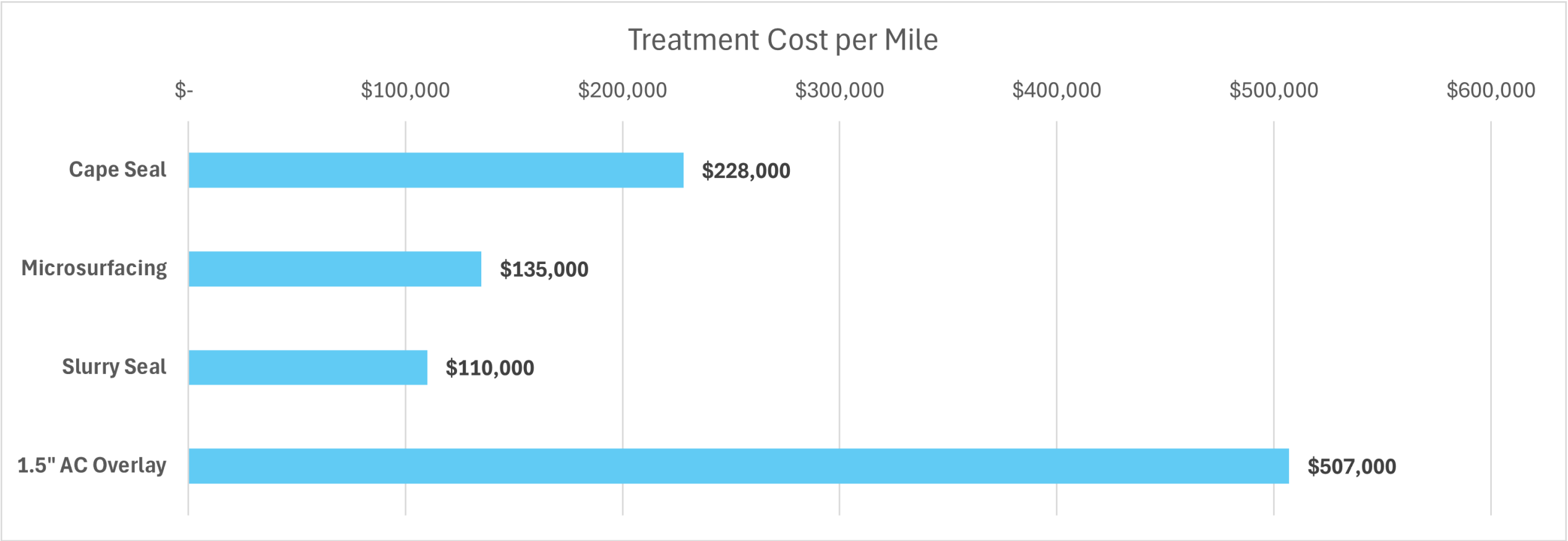




# Pavement Treatments for Residential Streets

- Residential Streets are roads in Urban Residential areas with Speed limit < 25 MPH
  - 132 centerline miles of the county road network system (24% of Road Network)
  - Current Overall PCI for Residential Street is 76.
    - 34% PCI > 80 (Very Good Condition)
    - 41% PCI 71-80 (Good Condition)
    - 24% PCI 50-70 (Fair Condition)
    - 1% PCI < 50 (Poor condition)
- Proposed Types of treatments on Residential Streets
  - Slurry Seal
  - Microsurfacing
  - Overlay
