**Subject:**      **Adoption of a Resolution Certifying Ventura County's Maintained Mileage – May 2024 to April 2025; All Supervisorial Districts.**

**Recommendations:**

Adopt the attached Resolution certifying Ventura County's maintained mileage as 542.65 miles.

**Fiscal Impact(s):**

There are no additional County costs associated with this Board action.

**Discussion:**

Section 2121 of the Streets and Highways Code requires annual certification of the number of miles of roadway being maintained by each county. This certification is required as part of the process for the apportionment of gas tax funds distributed under the provisions of Sections 2104 and 2105 of such Code, which provide for certain disbursements based on vehicle registration and maintained mileage. The state also requires all public agencies to submit certified maintained mileage to update the Highway Performance Monitoring System (HPMS).

The tabulation of Ventura County's maintained road mileage inventory as shown in Exhibit 1, covering the period from May 2024 to April 2025, indicates a total of 542.65 miles.
