Now the Governor of California has signed a Bill that codifies to the whole world that non-citizens are going to be allowed to and encouraged to vote in elections. This state has become the official poster child of corruption, surpassing even New York and Illinois for that claim to fame. Where was the pushback from this county? At this point, I request that a 100% hand count is conducted for the election, and full transparency from the County ROV is published regarding voter roll cleanup, including non-citizen identification practices and results, deceased voters, non-resident voters, and that these efforts by the ROV are published daily on the County website.
