1. Credit in cost for labor, equipment, tools, and material necessary for provided 4-inch diameter sounding / camera tube between depths of 770 feet to 780 feet and 4-inch by 6-foot port entrance chute. Constructed tube and port entrance chute does not meet the requirements of the specifications.
Cost.....(-) \$71,428.00
2. Credit in cost for labor, equipment, tools, and material necessary for provided casing between depths of 770 feet to 780 feet. Constructed casing does not meet the requirements of the specifications.
Cost.....(-) \$50,000.00
