

RESOLUTION NO. 24-002

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
DISSOLVING THE PIRU LOCAL PARKS ADVISORY COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Piru Local Parks Advisory Commission ("Piru Commission") is to advise the District 3 Supervisor, raise funds for parks and recreational equipment and services, and provide recommendations to the County Parks Department on local parks and recreational matters of the unincorporated Piru community;

WHEREAS, since the Piru Commission's formation by the Board of Supervisors ("Board") in 1978, the Piru Neighborhood Council ("PNC"), a non-profit organization that convenes regular public meetings, has assumed the role of the Piru community's primary advisor to the County. The PNC works closely with the County Parks Department and District 3 Supervisor's office, including regarding park and recreational matters;

WHEREAS, in recent years the Piru Commission has not been convened; and

WHEREAS, based on the lack of recent activity of and continuing need for the Piru Commission, the Board wishes to dissolve the Piru Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby dissolves the Piru Local Parks Advisory Commission effective immediately.

Upon a motion by Supervisor LaVere, and seconded by Supervisor Lopez, duly carried, the foregoing Resolution was passed and adopted this 9th day of January, 2024.
