



PROCLAIMING NOVEMBER 2023
NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH

WHEREAS, NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH TAKES PLACE ANNUALLY DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER AS A TIME TO HONOR THE DIVERSE CULTURES, TRADITIONS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF NATIVE AMERICANS AND CELEBRATE THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF NATIVE AMERICANS PAST, PRESENT, AND FUTURE IN VENTURA COUNTY; AND

WHEREAS, WE ACKNOWLEDGE THE COUNTY OF VENTURA'S PRESENCE ON THE TRADITIONAL, ANCESTRAL, AND UNCEDED LAND OF THE CHUMASH PEOPLES. WE SEEK TO PRIORITIZE RESPECT FOR CHUMASH CULTURE AND THE CONTEMPORARY AND FUTURE PRESENCE OF NATIVE AMERICANS THROUGHOUT VENTURA COUNTY. WE RECOGNIZE THE CHUMASH AS THE ORIGINAL STEWARDS OF THIS LAND WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY RECOGNIZING EVERYONE'S COLLECTIVE RESPONSIBILITY TOGETHER, TO CONTINUE TO CARE FOR THIS LAND; AND

WHEREAS, AS THE COUNTY OF VENTURA OBSERVES AND RECOGNIZES THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF NATIVE AMERICAN VETERANS, AND THAT NATIVE AMERICANS SERVE IN THE ARMED FORCES AT A HIGHER PER CAPITA RATE THAN THE OVERALL POPULATION; AND

WHEREAS, THE COUNTY OF VENTURA RECOGNIZES THAT THE MOVEMENT TOWARD EQUALITY FOR NATIVE AMERICANS CONTINUES TO THIS DAY AND WE ASPIRE TO REPAIR PAST HARM BY INCLUDING THE INTERESTS OF NATIVE AMERICANS IN DECISION-MAKING, WELCOMING OPEN DIALOGUE AND COURAGEOUS CONVERSATIONS TO ADVANCE THIS WORK, AND STRIVING TOGETHER TO BUILD A FUTURE OF SHARED HOPE AND PROMISE FOR ALL; AND

WHEREAS, THE BARBAREÑO-VENTUREÑO BAND OF MISSION INDIANS, (BVBMI) IS A TRIBAL BAND OF CHUMASH PEOPLE IN VENTURA COUNTY AND REPRESENTS AND SERVES THE CHUMASH COMMUNITY USHERING CHUMASH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE INTO THE FUTURE; AND


