



# County Service Area No. 30 (Nyeland Acres)

## Administration

- County of Ventura, Supervisorial District No. 5
- The County of Ventura Board of Supervisors is the governing Board.
- The Water and Sanitation Department is responsible for the administration, operation, and maintenance of the sewer collection system.

## Overview

- Formed November 2, 1965
- Area served: The community of Nyeland Acres, lying within an area bounded by U.S. Highway 101 on the south, Santa Clara Avenue on the west, The Del Norte Blvd. off-ramp on the east, and the Nyeland Drain on the north.
- Size of District: Encompasses approximately 177 acres
- Population Served: Approximately 893
- Wastewater treatment plant was removed in 1999.
- Number of Accounts: 275
- Sewage is pumped to the City of Oxnard for wastewater treatment and disposal.
- Until June 1999, Ventura Regional Sanitation District operated and maintained the system under a separate contract with the County.
- On July 1, 1999, the Water and Sanitation Department assumed the operation and maintenance responsibilities

## Major Projects Completed in the Last 10 Years


### CIP Sanitation

- In 2005, replaced prior existing STEP system with gravity sewer collection system, and abandoned the WWTP
- SCADA/County Microwave System Upgrade
- Asset Mgmt. CMMS with GIS field devices & access to Record Drawings
- Cleaned 100% sewer system
- Pump replacement at Nyeland lift station
