BACKGROUND:

Ventura County Health Care Agency Ambulatory Care has provided medical services at the CSUCI Student Health Center for the students of CSUCI since the campus opened in 2002. This highly rewarding and successful collaboration has led to cost effective, high quality medical care for the students enrolled at the first and only Ventura County public university. The medical services provided at CSUCI include primary care of acute and sub-acute conditions, illness and injury, family planning services, health education, women’s health care and immunizations.

DISCUSSION:

The proposed agreement will provide the County of Ventura Health Care Agency with the ability to continue medical services at the CSUCI Student Health Center for students of CSUCI.
