RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That your Board receive and file the 2023 Detention Facilities Inspection Reports

FISCAL/MANDATES IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action. The costs to prepare and process the Detention Facility Inspection Reports are included in the Environmental Health Division's Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Adopted Budget.

STRATEGIC PLAN:
