

Ventura County Animal Services (VCAS) is responsible for operating the existing Animal Shelter. The facility in Camarillo provides various services including animal housing, pet adoptions, lost & found, field operations, cruelty investigations, pet licensing, medical care, low-cost vaccination clinics, volunteer/foster opportunities, and emergency disaster response. Alongside the unincorporated area, VCAS also provides contract animal services to the residents of Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Simi Valley, Ventura. Shelter leadership and staff are dedicated to improving the lives of the animals in their care and educating residents and stakeholders throughout the region.  The County is looking to modernize the Shelter. Several counties across the state have already completed (San Luis Obispo) or are in the development stages (San Diego) for renovated animal shelters. The existing VCAS facility was built in 1985 and is approximately 30,000 square feet. Several modifications have been made to the building (s) over the years.
