He has also been the auctioneer emeritus for the Boys & Girls Club of Camarillo auctions, as well as for many other local charities and for many years ensured Santa's attendance at the annual Holiday Party at the Boys & Girls Club; and

Whereas, Randy has also been active in the Camarillo Rotary Club, Mount Cross Lutheran Church, Camarillo AYSO, and has served on the Board of Camarillo Hospice, and currently serves on the Board of Miracle League of the 805; and



Whereas, Randy's favorite activities are watching his grandkids compete in sports, being with friends, and singing in his church's choir.


