Whereas, Robert Burckhard began his career with the Ventura County Sheriff's Office on January 3, 1999. Robert entered the Ventura County Sheriff's Academy with Class 99-1 and graduated on June 27, 1999. Robert was promoted to Deputy Sheriff in June of 1999 after graduating from the Academy and was assigned to the Todd Road Jail Facility. Robert stood out early in his law enforcement career receiving multiple commendations while in his custody assignment for his tenacity, professionalism, and dedication; and


Whereas, Robert obtained his Bachelor of Arts degree from California State University of San Francisco in 1996. Robert continued his quest for life-long learning and attended numerous law enforcement courses and certification courses; and

Whereas, in December of 2001, Robert was transferred to the Thousand Oaks Police Station to begin his patrol assignment. In September of 2002, he was transferred to the Moorpark Police Station where he held various patrol assignments from 2002 to 2015. During his assignment at the Moorpark Police Station, Robert received multiple commendations for professionalism and dependability. Robert was also selected as a Field Training Officer while at the Moorpark Police where he had the opportunity to teach and mentor the newer deputies assigned to patrol as a Field Training Officer; and

Whereas, in November of 2015, Robert was transferred to Court Services where he was assigned as a bailiff. He remained a bailiff in the Ventura County Superior Court until April 2017 when he was selected and assigned to the Civil Unit. In February 2020, Robert transferred to the Hall of Justice where he was assigned until November 2022. In November 2022, Robert was selected and assigned to the East County Jail where he completed his successful career; and




