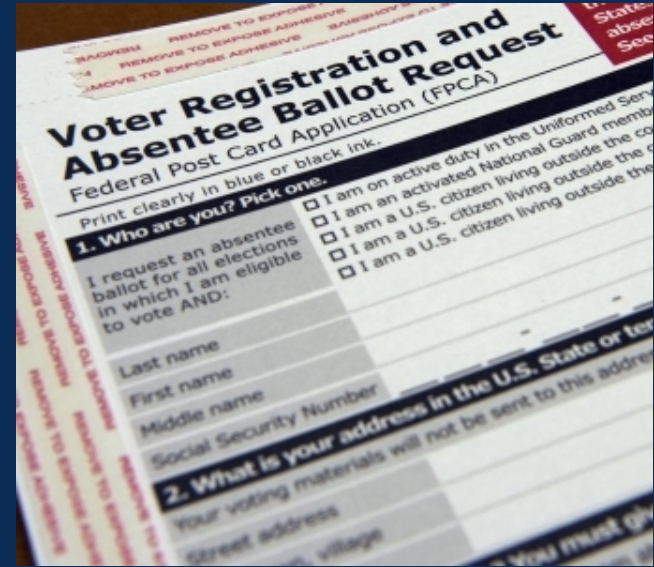
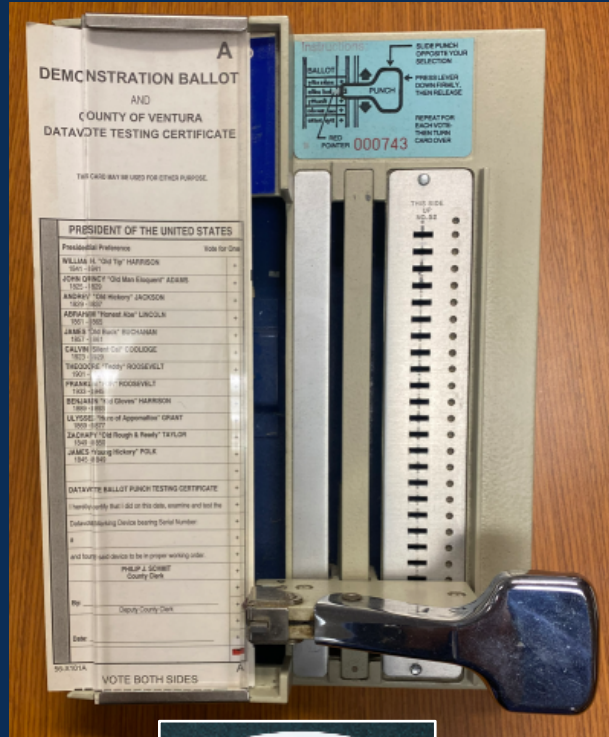
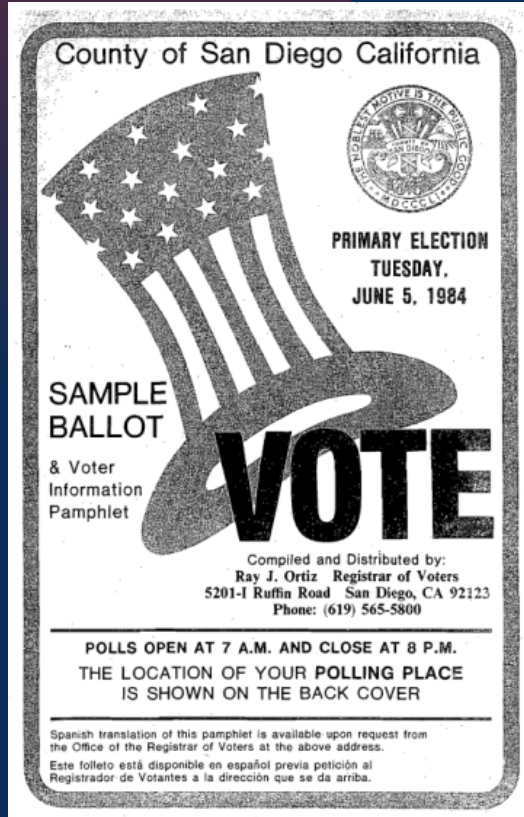

VOTE SAFE CALIFORNIA


Every registered voter in California will receive a vote-by-mail ballot.

Vote-by-mail ballots are mailed on or before February 5.


Vote-by-mail ballots can be voted and returned as soon as they are received.

Vote-by-mail drop boxes open February 6.

In-person voting options will be available in all counties.

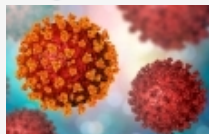

Ventura County Clerk-Recorder, Registrar of Voters Mark Lunn Announces Important Details Regarding November 3, 2020 General Election

(Ventura) – Under Executive Order, the Governor declared the November 3, 2020 General Election an all Vote By Mail election in the state of California. County Clerk-Recorder, Registrar of Voters Lunn stated, "With the current Coronavirus pandemic and the confluence of the flu season upon us, I encourage all voters to utilize the Vote By Mail ballot they receive at home to take advantage of the health and safety measures that voting by mail provides."

The Ventura County Elections Division will deliver ballots to the United States Post Office on Friday, October 2, three days ahead of schedule. All registered voters will automatically receive a ballot at their mailing address on file.

(Ventura) – The Ventura County Registrar of Voters will hold a virtual public hearing on the draft Election Administration Plan (EAP) on December 15, 2021, in accordance with the County's upcoming transition to the California Voter's Choice Act (VCA) for the upcoming June 2022 election. Language interpretation will be available in the following languages: Spanish, Tagalog, Chinese, Vietnamese, and Gujarati.

The draft EAP was developed through a series of community meetings to gather feedback on the new voting model that will modernize the way Ventura County residents vote. The draft EAP is posted online in all required languages at VenturaVote.org under the "California Voter's Choice Act" icon.

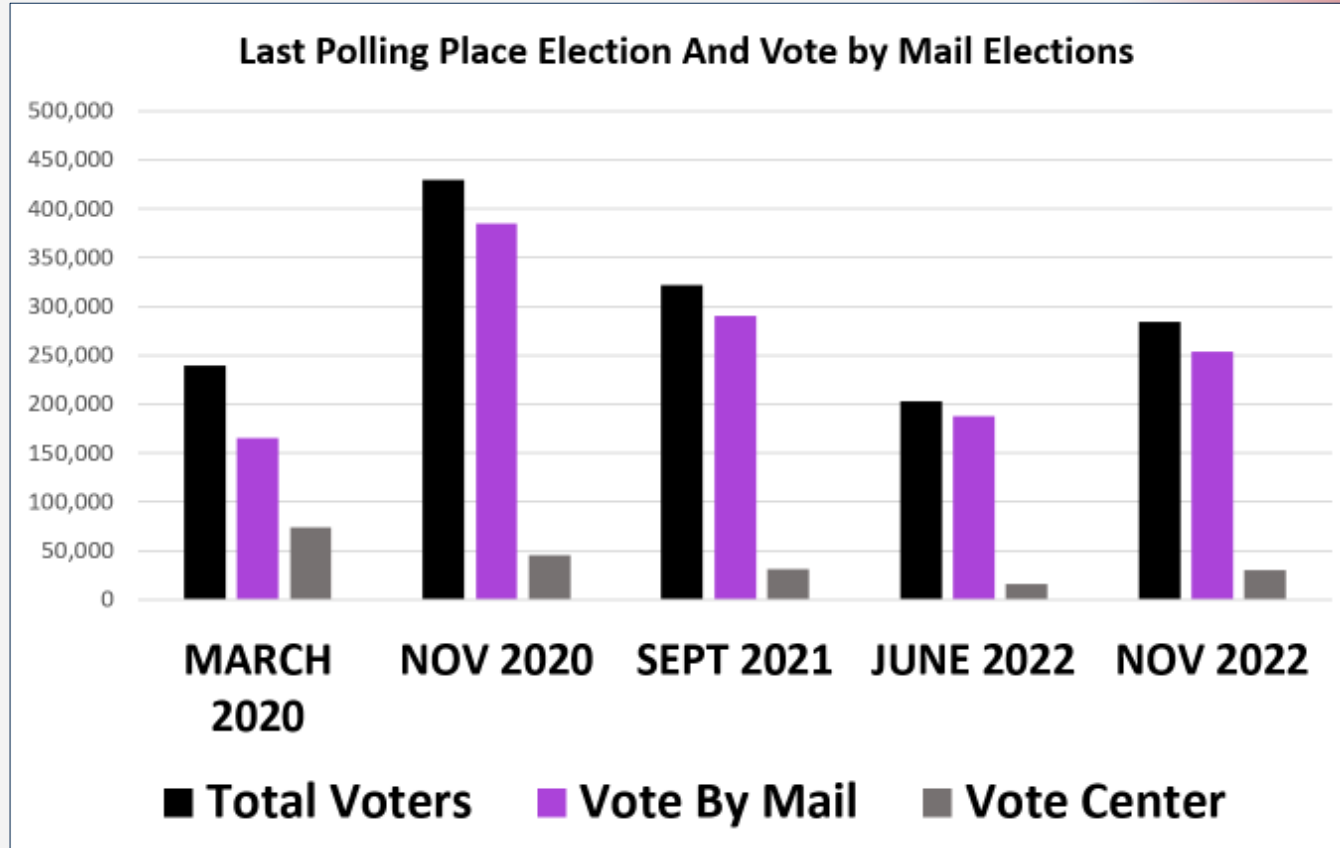

(Ventura) – Mark Lunn, Ventura County Clerk-Recorder and Registrar of Voters, received notification last week that the recently submitted Voters Choice Act ("VCA") Election Administration Plan ("EAP") received full approval by the California Secretary of State's Office. This approval caps a months-long plan development effort and adds Ventura County to the growing number of VCA counties in California.

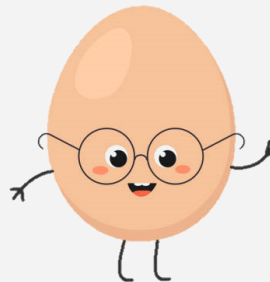
