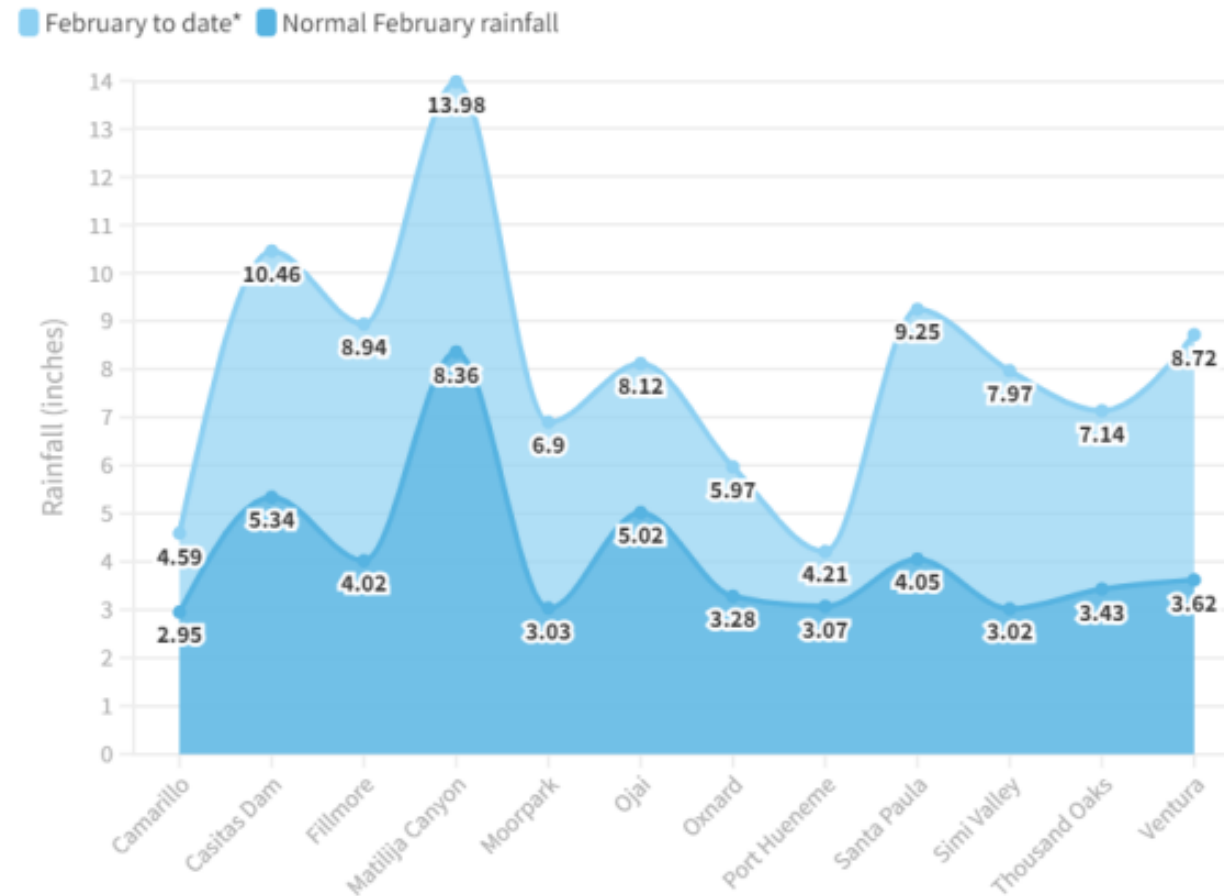

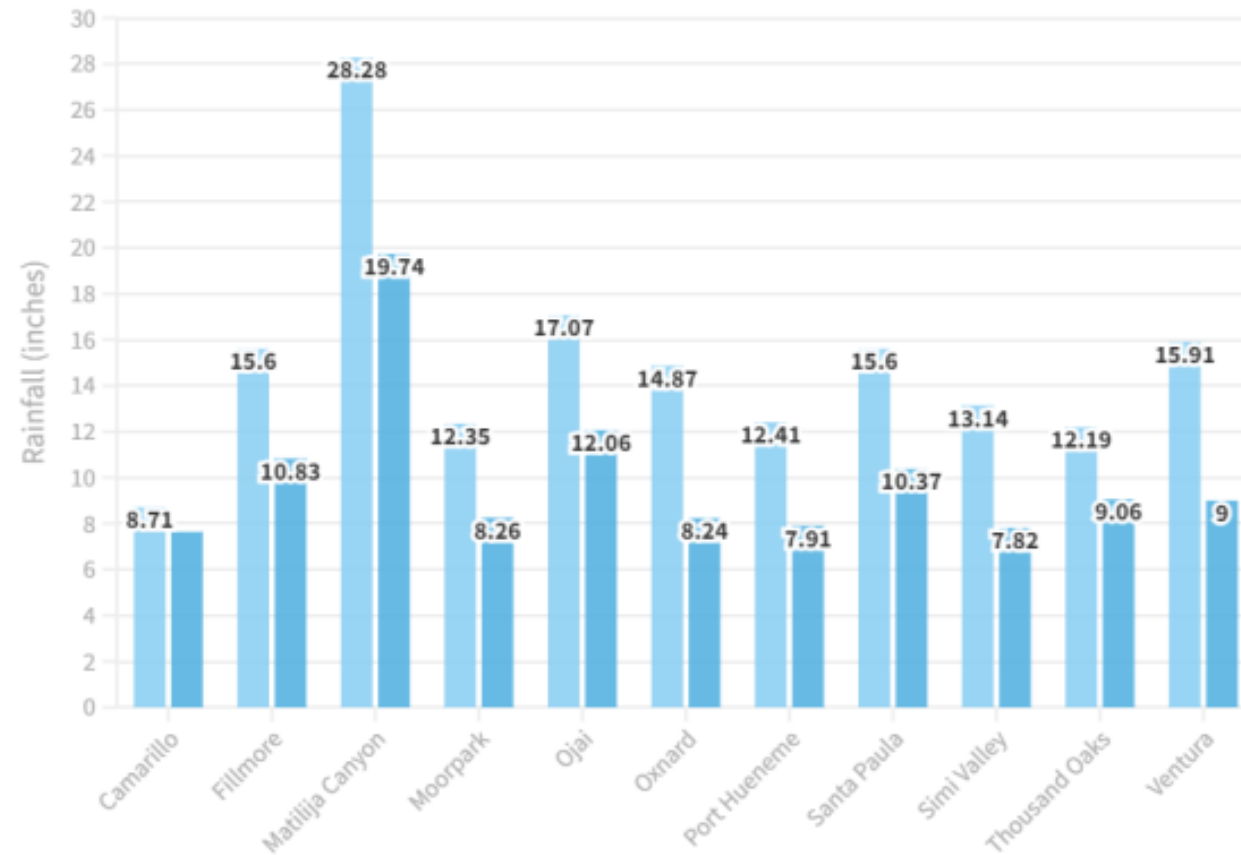

Here's how this season compares to normal

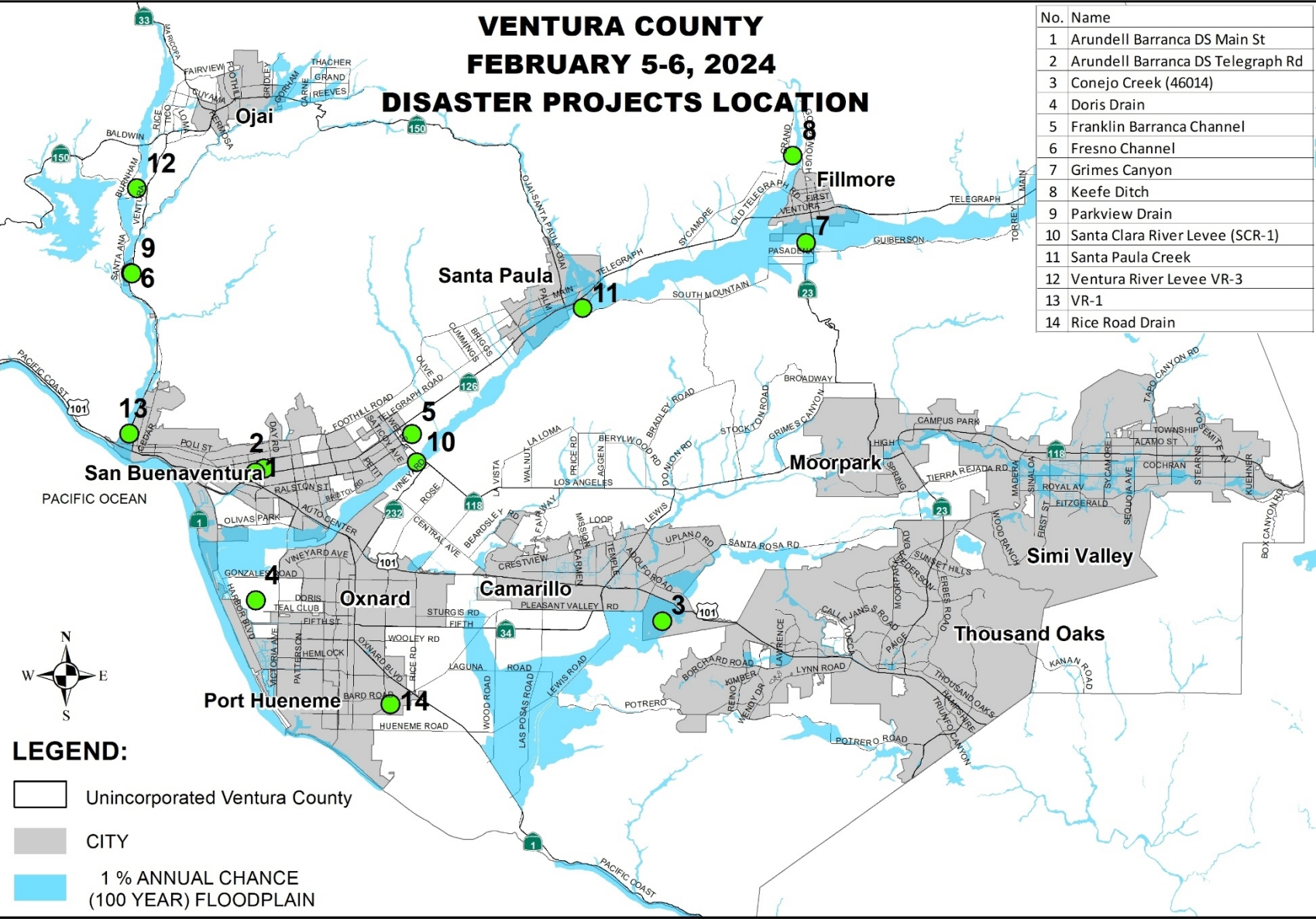
■ Rainfall 2023-24 to date* ■ Normal to date

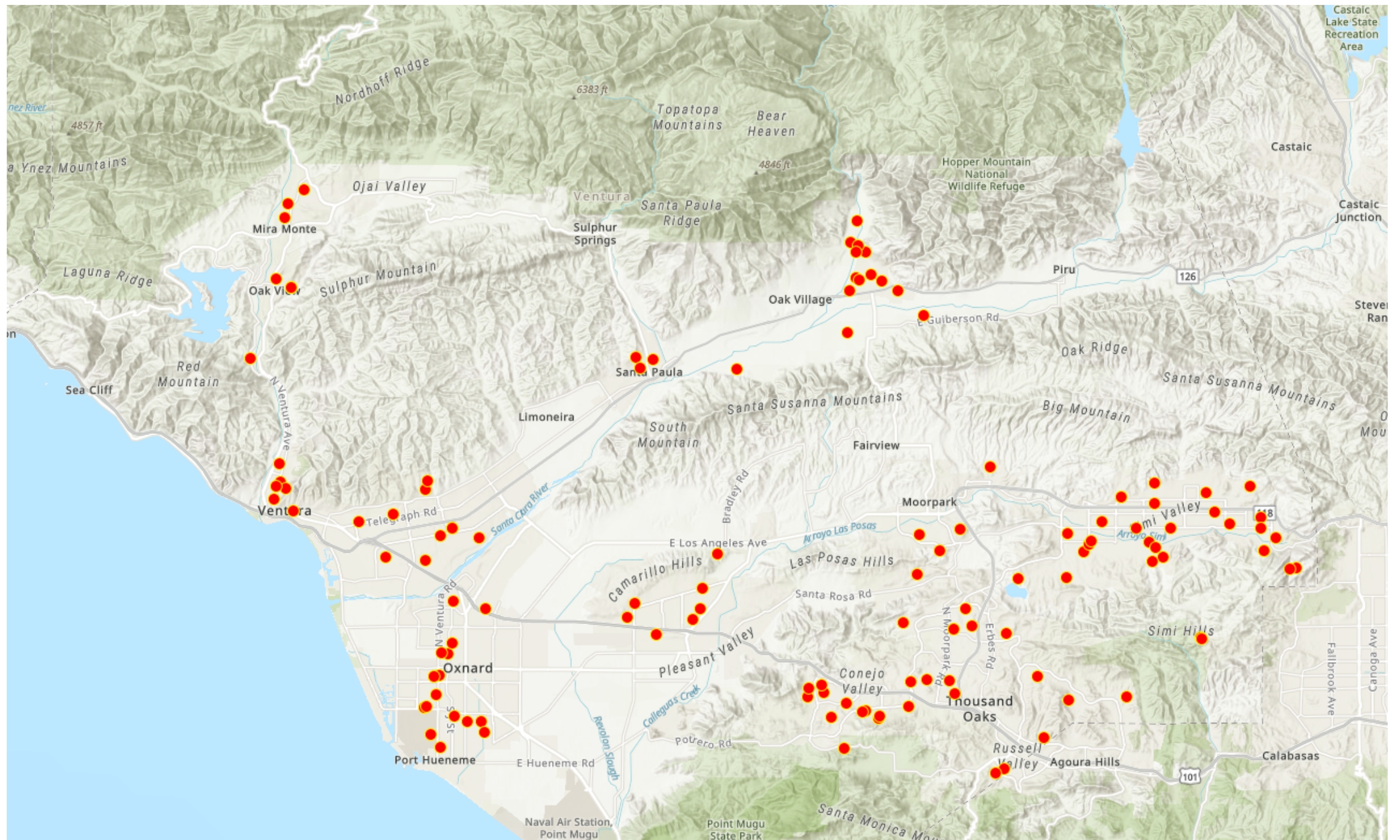

Damage to Residential Structures

117 residential damage reports have been received.

- 84 reports of water intrusion into the structures
 - 1"-6" – 74 structures
 - 7"-17" – 7 structures
 - >18" – 3 structures

****This level of damage remains below the threshold required to trigger FEMA assistance.****



Emergency Proclamations

- Emergency Proclamations must be issued by jurisdictions within 10 days of the start of an incident.
 - Proclamation must be ratified by the elected body having jurisdiction within 7 days of issuance.

- County of Ventura – February 8, 2024
 - City of Ventura - February 6, 2024
 - City of Fillmore— February 13, 2024

Next Steps

- Complete Preliminary Damage Assessment with Cal OES and FEMA personnel.
 - Do not anticipate having difficulty meeting our damage threshold for public agencies.
 - \$3,800,000 in Ventura County
 - \$74,000,000 statewide
- Information is submitted to FEMA HQ and a recommendation is made to the President on authorizing a Federal Disaster Declaration.
 - Process can take => month before a decision is made.
