2017 Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery Funds



2017 THOMAS FIRE

- Thomas Fire burned 208,203 acres of land
- Destroyed more than 750 Ventura County homes and damaged 180
- The County was awarded \$2.75 million in Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recover funds from the State of California Department of Housing & Community Development (HCD) for the purpose of developing affordable rental housing for low-income households
- County issued a NOFA and three projects were selected to receive CDBG-DR funds

68 units of affordable housing,

1 manager's unit

- 22 units of farmworker housing





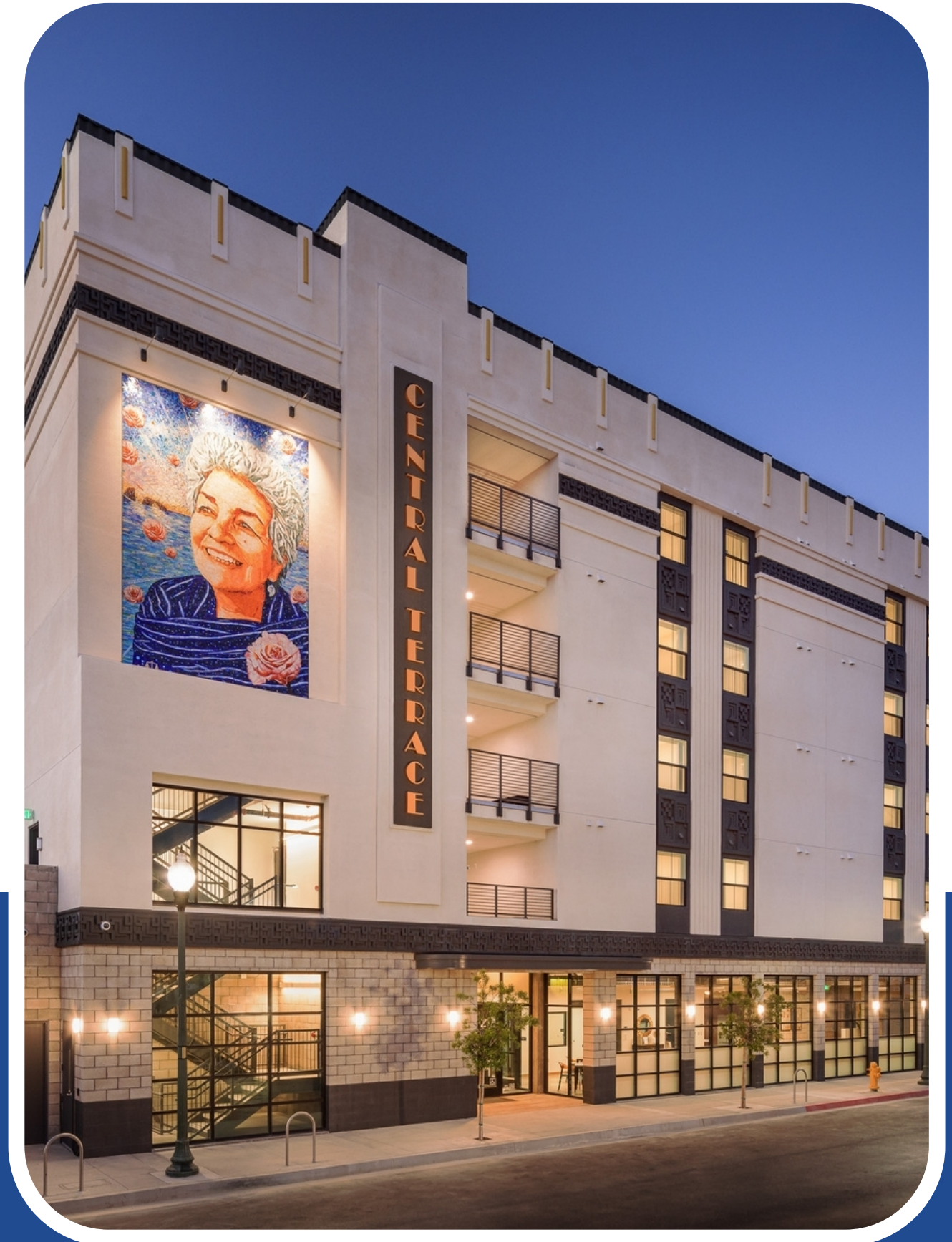
MANY MANSIONS **CENTRAL TERRACE**

WESTVIEW VILLAGE II

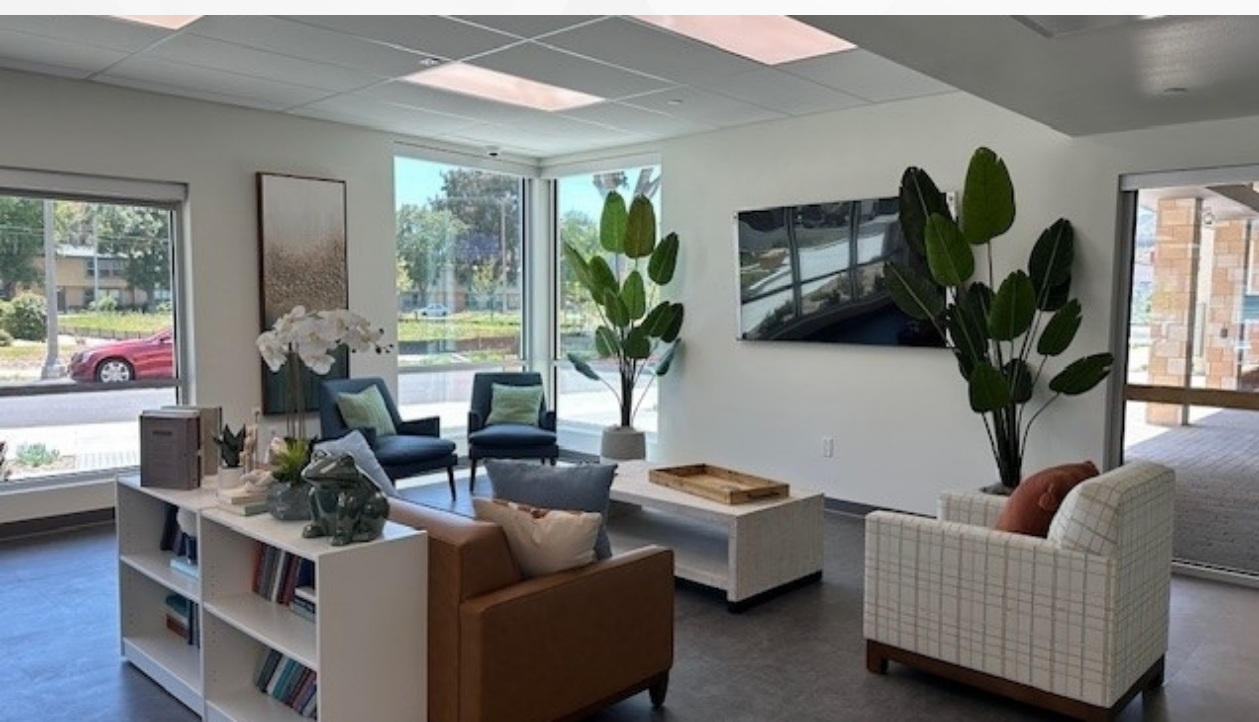
Located in Ventura
