

RESOLUTION NO. 23-128
RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FOR
THE CARMEN RAMIREZ FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER

WHEREAS, the Ventura County District Attorney's Office desires to enhance the Carmen Ramirez Family Justice Center using funds made available through the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime (OVC) – Byrne Discretionary Community Project Funding/Byrne Discretionary Grants Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney of the County of Ventura or his designee is authorized to accept federal funds for the Carmen Ramirez Family Justice Center in the amount of \$640,000 from the OVC; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney or his designee is authorized to execute the Award Instrument, including any extensions or amendments thereof, subject to the review and approval of County Counsel; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.

On motion of Supervisor Long, seconded by Supervisor Parvin, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted on this 26th day of September 2023.
