

RESOLUTION NO. 23-167

**RESOLUTION OF THE VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A CONSOLIDATED COASTAL  
DEVELOPMENT PERMIT FOR SILVER STRAND AND HOLLYWOOD BEACHES**

**WHEREAS**, the Ventura County Board of Supervisors adopted the Ventura County Local Coastal Plan Amendment, Resolution No. 21-142 on October 19, 2021, which updated section 4.1.3-3. Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Areas (ESHA) Programs to implement ESHA Program 6, County Beach Maintenance Master Permit and Beach Management Plan;

**WHEREAS**, the California Coastal Commission (CCC) approved the Ventura County Local Coastal Plan Amendment No. LCP-4-vnt-21-0069-2 (Phase 2C) on September 9, 2022;

**WHEREAS**, the beach areas of Silver Strand and Hollywood Beaches are not within the Channel Islands Harbor Public Works Plan-governed coastal area, the County of Ventura Harbor Department (Harbor) has historically overseen all management and maintenance of the beach areas;

**WHEREAS**, the beach areas of Silver Strand and Hollywood Beaches are governed by the Ventura County's Local Coastal Program (LCP) and Coastal Zoning Ordinances;

**WHEREAS**, the CCC retains original permit jurisdiction from 50 feet seaward of existing dwellings to three miles offshore;

**WHEREAS**, the jurisdictional overlap necessitates direct CCC approval for any development within this area;

**WHEREAS**, the Coastal Act Section 30601.3 authorizes the CCC to process a consolidated coastal development permit application when the local government agency, the applicant, and the CCC all agree the CCC should do so; and

**WHEREAS**, in order for the County Harbor Department (Harbor) to apply for a multi-year "master permit" to comprehensively address development, including beach maintenance activities conducted by the County at Hollywood and Silver Strand Beaches, the County must consent to the CCC to process consolidated Coastal Development Permits with the Commission.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Ventura County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein as though set forth in full;
2. The Harbor will apply for a consolidated Coastal Development Permit to comprehensively address development, including beach maintenance activities conducted by the County at Hollywood and Silver Strand Beaches pursuant to Ventura County Coastal Area Plan, ESHA Program 6; and

3. The Director of the County of Ventura Harbor Department, Michael Tripp, is authorized and directed to submit to the California Coastal Commission a consolidated Coastal Development Permit Application for Silver Strand and Hollywood Beaches on behalf of the County.

Upon motion of Supervisor Parvin, seconded by Supervisor Lopez, and duly carried, the Board hereby adopts the foregoing resolution on the 19th day of December 2023.
