A public hearing was held by the VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS on Tuesday, July 25, 2023, at 2:30 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, County Government Center, Hall of Administration, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, California, 93009.

LOCATION: All non-coastal unincorporated areas of Ventura County (All Districts)

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4618:

The adopted ordinance amends Articles 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 11, 13 and 19 of the Ventura County Non-Coastal Zoning Ordinance (NCZO). The ordinance amendment incorporates existing maximum building lot coverage development standards contained in the Ventura County General Plan, Area Plans, and previously repealed General Plan Goals, Policies and Programs into Articles 2 and 6 of the NCZO. The ordinance amendment also includes adding bay windows to the existing setback exception for chimneys and fireplaces under Section 8106-S.7 of the NCZO. Also included in the ordinance are grammatical, stylistic, definitional, and other clarifying amendments to Articles 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 11, 13 and 19.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW: The ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3).

The ordinance was adopted by the following vote:
