Subject: Authorization for the Director of Ventura County Public Health Department to Transfer Prop 56 Oral Health Program Appropriations and Revenue from Children's Medical Services Unit 3143 to Public Health Unit 3105 to Appropriately Align the Program with Available Resources; Authorization for the Auditor-Controller to Process the Necessary Budgetary Transactions. Recommendation No. 2 Requires 4/5ths Vote.

Recommendations:

- That your Board authorize the Director of Ventura County Public Health
 Department to transfer Prop 56 Oral Health Program appropriations and revenue
 from Children's Medical Services Unit 3143 to Public Health Unit 3105 to
 appropriately align the program with available resources.

Discussion:

On November 8, 2016, California voters approved the California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act (commonly known as Prop. 56) to increase the excise tax rate on cigarettes and tobacco products. Under Prop. 56, a specified portion of the tobacco tax revenue is allocated to the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) to help fund health care expenditures. This Prop. 56 revenue includes the opportunity for Ventura County Public Health Department (VCPH) to receive funding from DHCS to provide dental services commonly known as the Prop 56 Oral Health Program.

The County's Prop 56 Oral Health Program was originally established in the HCA Children's Medical Services Unit 3143. In order to better align this program with the health education programs in Public Health VCPH is requesting that your Board authorize the transfer of appropriations and revenue from CMS Unit 3143 to PUB Unit 3105. This change will allow VCPH to more effectively and efficiently implement the program.

Prop 56 Oral Health Program aligns with Focus Area 4, Community Well Being; Strategic Goal 1, Objectives 1 and 3 of the Ventura County Strategic Plan.

Health in All Policies:

The VCPH Prop 56 Oral Health Program is committed to the task of improving the dental health of all Ventura County residents.
