Subject:

Approval of a Specialist Care Professional Services Agreement with Clinicas del Camino Real, Inc., for Specialty Services, Effective July 1, 2019; Ratification of the Health Care Agency's Performance Under the Agreement Pending Board Approval.

Recommendations:

- 1. That your Board approve, and authorize the Health Care Agency (HCA) Director or designee to sign, the attached Specialist Care Professional Services Agreement with Clinicas del Camino Real, Inc. (CDCR), for specialty services, effective July 1, 2019.
- 2. That your Board ratify HCA's performance under the attached agreement pending your Board's approval.

HCA provided services to CDCR members in anticipation of your Board's approval of this agreement.

The intent is always to recover the full cost. Due to the variability of supplemental program funding like the Quality Improvement Program specific to the Managed Medicaid population, the negotiated rate may not cover the full cost of care. The rate is an increase over the current rate the County is receiving for CDCR's patients.

*The operational income includes "Operating Transfers In" that is primarily attributed to County contributions. Sufficient revenue and appropriations were budgeted in the FY 19-20 budget.

Discussion:

In April 2012 the County of Ventura (County) began to provide specialty care services to CDCR members. The agreement before your Board continues the relationship between County and CDCR to ensure that County citizens have access to quality and comprehensive health care.

CDCR is the second largest network of Federally Qualified Health Centers in Ventura County delivering a fully integrated system of health care services. The CDCR network includes fourteen (14) health centers providing family medicine, dental care, mental health services, vision care, and health education. The attached specialty services agreement strengthens the relationship between HCA and CDCR and demonstrates the focus of both entities remains on the care of the patient.

The portions of the agreement concerning compensation paid to the County are exempt from disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act (Health and Safety Code Section 1457(c)(1)).
