Discussion:

In December of 2013, the Sheriff's Special Investigative Bureau was contacted by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (Border Protection) and the San Diego County Sheriff's Department and asked to assist in a regional joint operations task force. Per the Agreement (attached as Exhibit 1 hereto), the San Diego County Sheriff's Department, using funds from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (Border Protection), will reimburse the Ventura County Sheriff's Office up to \$390,000 during the term of the Agreement for overtime and equipment associated with this joint operations task force. The term of this Agreement runs from September 1, 2018 through May 31, 2021. We ask that your Board authorize the Sheriff to sign the agreement (attached Exhibit 1) and grant assurances (attached hereto as Exhibit 2) and accept these funds.
