Pre-Opening

- Mid 80's conceived to meet an urgent County need –
 EMERGENCY SHELTER for abused, neglected children
- Designed to be public/private partnership
 - Steering committee County staff & Casa Pacifica Board members
 - shared capital campaign for campus construction
- \$10 Million Capital Campaign credited with "moving philanthropy to next level" in Ventura County
- Decision made to have "private entity" operate the programs rather than the County to keep community involved

Children / Youth Served

- Admitted into one of our programs more than 27,000 Ventura County children & youth (another 15,000 from Santa Barbara & other counties)
- Focus on most challenging youth in our community
- 15 Programs 4 on campus;
 11 in community
- All programs nationally accredited
- Only APA approved internship on central coast specialty in child/adolescents
- National & international training & consultation



Community Impact

- Raised \$55 million since opening
- 20,000 volunteers have supported children & youth in our programs and events
- Wine, Food, & Brew named "Best Charity Event/Festival" for 7 years & counting
- Voted "Best Non-Profit" for 7 Years & counting
- 2019-20 budget approved at \$31 million
- 335 staff
- Successfully finished \$16.6 million capital campaign to expand campus services
