Ocean View School District was recently informed about a Renaissance Petroleum Expansion Project that was approved within the boundaries of the District. I currently understand that the project will add four (4) wells and a production facility to the property on Nauman Road south of Etting Road. I understand that the proposed production facility will service a total of 35 wells.

As Superintendent, I am contacting you to communicate the District's concerns regarding the safety of students, families and staff. First, the project approves an increase of trucks entering and exiting the proposed facility and traveling the same routes and at the same times used by our buses transporting students to and from school. Additionally, the District has concerns about potential negative impacts from pollutants based on increased operation of the "flare" as production increases. Finally, the District is concerned about potential dangers of a large production facility in close proximity to several schools and facilities.

I look forward to speaking with you further about the District's concerns.

Honorable Chair and Members of the Planning Commission

When the Ventura County Planning Commission ("Commission") considers Citizens for Responsible Oil and Gas (CFROG) and Food & Water Watch's appeal of the Planning Director's determination regarding the Renaissance Petroleum, LLC Oil and Gas Facility (Case No. PL 14-0103), the City Council of the City of Oxnard requests that the Commission carefully consider the health and safety of Oxnard residents in making its final decision.

Sensitive residential uses at Oxnard Pacific Mobile Estates within Oxnard city limits are located less than 1600 feet from the Renaissance Petroleum, LLC Oil and Gas Facility site, which is proposed to expand from one oil and gas well to five oil and gas wells. In addition, a possible truck route for the transport of the oil (on Dodge Road) is located directly adjacent to Oxnard Pacific Mobile Estates.

If the Commission is inclined to uphold the decision of the Planning Director, the City Council requests that the final conditions of approval ensure that the health and safety of Oxnard residents are fully and properly addressed. These conditions include (but are not limited to) prohibiting tanker trucks traveling on Dodge Road or the portion of Etting Road located west of the oil and gas facility, and ensuring that the facility (including drilling and ongoing operations) strictly comply with the noise and safety regulations.


I serve on the Planning Commission for the City of Portland, OR, so appreciate the work that goes into permit and land use reviews.
