Authorization for the Sheriff's Office to Accept Unanticipated State Criminal Alien Assistance Program Funding in the Amount of \$411,544; Authorization for the Auditor-Controller to Process the Necessary Budgetary Transactions to Adjust Appropriations and Unanticipated Revenue in the Amount \$411,544 (RECOMMENDATION #2 REQUIRES 4/5th VOTE).

Recommendations:

It is recommended that your Board:

- 1. Authorize the Sheriff to accept additional State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) funds of \$411,544.
- 2. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to process the necessary budgetary transactions to adjust appropriations and unanticipated revenue as follows within the Sheriff's Detention Administration, Division 2550, Unit 2551 (requires 4/5th vote):

Discussion:

SCAAP provides federal assistance to states and localities for costs incurred in incarcerating undocumented criminal aliens who have been convicted of two misdemeanors or one felony and were in custody for a minimum of four consecutive days. The 2017 data collection methodology requires that all potentially eligible inmates in the Sheriff's custody be counted for a one-year period from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. Reimbursement is associated with routine detention operational costs for eligible inmates that are housed by the Sheriff during the year. SCAAP reimbursement is a pro rata share of the costs attributed to housing potentially eligible inmates in Ventura County Sheriff's Detention Facilities.

Budgeted SCAAP revenue for FY 18-19 was \$515,193. The Sheriff's Office received \$926,737 in February 2019, related to the program year 2017. The Sheriff's Office is requesting an increase in unanticipated revenue of \$411,544 and corresponding increase in appropriations.
