Subject:

Approval of, and Authorization for Chair of the Board of Supervisors to Sign, a Fourth Amendment to the Agreement for Advanced Network (Data) Services Between the County of Ventura and Califa Group to Provide for an Additional Circuit to Museum of Ventura County, to Provide for the Potential for Four Additional One-Year Period Contract Renewals, and to Increase the Annual Contract Not to Exceed Amount to \$230,000 for FY 2019-20 and Future Years.

Recommendation:

1. Approve and authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign a fourth amendment to the agreement for advanced network (data) services between the County of Ventura and Califa Group for the provision, installation and maintenance of an additional data circuit to Museum of Ventura County, to provide for the potential for four additional one-year period contract renewals, and to increase the contract not to exceed amount from \$220,000 to \$230,000 annually in FY 2019-2020 and future years.

DISCUSSION:

Your Board approved the agreement between County of Ventura and Califa Group on March 3, 2015 to join the Corporation for Education Network Incentives in California (CENIC). The purpose of joining CENIC high speed educational and research network is to receive far greater broadband speed, with more capacities at substantial discounts on telecommunications costs for the Ventura County Library.

The Museum of Ventura County (Museum) has added records for its holdings in the Museum Research Library into the Ventura County Library's online catalog for many years. The Ventura County Library's online catalog has been made available at the Museum Research Library for customers to search holdings. Ventura County Library will add a new Gigabit circuit to this location to expand access to the CENIC high speed network. The additional pre discount cost of this circuit is \$8,781 annually, plus additional variable taxes and surcharges. This circuit will be eligible under E-rate for the current year.

The current Agreement provides for no further contract renewals after June 30, 2020. Amendment 4 will provide for four additional one-year period contract renewals unless one party notifies the other within the period specified by contract. The contract not to exceed amount for FY 2018-19 remains at \$220,000, and for FY 2019-20 and future years it will now be \$230,000. This has been included in the FY2019-20 preliminary budget request.
