DISCUSSION:

The Ventura County Library READ program helps adults improve reading and writing skills to positively impact their lives in such areas as self-esteem, employment, family life, and community involvement. Library staff have been using an online program from LiteracyPro Systems called Literacy, Adult, and Community Education System (LACES) as a volunteer management tool. However, this tool was developed for adult school programs, and staff have identified a need for an online program that is tailored more to the specific needs of literacy programs.

The America Learns Impact Suite online program has been used by many other public library literacy programs across the state, and will provide a private comprehensive data management system for the READ program. This data-management system is specific to literacy programs and will provide a significant improvement over the LACES system currently in use. Among the benefits provided will be four two-hour training sessions for staff and separate PowerPoint presentations for ongoing staff and volunteer training.

The most significant improvement allows active participation from volunteers who will be trained to enter their weekly attendance on the site, which is also a time-saver for staff when reminder messages are sent automatically. After volunteer tutors enter data they will be asked if they have questions related to their current instructional topics. If they

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choose to enter a question they will receive lesson plan ideas and video clips of actual lessons the next time they log-on.

The Library requests the Board of Supervisors to set a contract not-to-exceed amount for FY 2018-19 and FY 2019-20 of \$7,500. This has been included in the FY2019-20 preliminary budget request.
