## **Voluntary Rehabilitation Effort**

- Pre-filing
- Low level misdemeanors
- Distant or no misd criminal history
- Voluntary
- Restitution

**Education, with Savings**  Pacific Educational Services (PES) Cognitive behavioral therapy Offender funded No cost or revenue to County Indigent offender fund

### 2018 - Encouraging Start

- 616 invited
- 365 enrolled
- 93% completed
- Only 21 people dropped out
  \$12,000 restitution to victims

#### 2018 – Recidivism Comparison

274 completed the program
Only 1 new conviction – 0.36%

272 declined or dropped out
31 new convictions – 11.40%

# Indigent Fund Performance Nearly 10% requested fee reduction Two-thirds of requests granted

\$8,800+in reduced program fees

#### **Positive Impacts**

- 273 people succeeded
- 1.8% misd cases not filed
- Crime victims reimbursed
- Public safety protected
- Our community benefitted
