Discussion for Recommendation 1:

On February 19, 2019, the VCLS received a generous donation from the Port Hueneme Friends of the Library in the amount of \$11,000. These funds are specifically allocated for purchases of books and other library materials for both adults and children. The donation will be used to purchase new and updated nonfiction books for children and teens, bilingual Spanish-English picture books and early readers, graphic novels, and media. Purchases of new materials for adults will focus on fiction and nonfiction books and media and will include both English and Spanish-language materials. This welcome donation from the Friends will allow the Prueter Library to enhance several of its best-used collections.

Reason for Ratification:

Staff were not aware of this donation in advance and prepared the Board letter as soon as the Library received the money.

Discussion for Recommendation 2:

Adjustments to appropriations include an increase of \$11,000 for services and supplies. Adjustments to revenue include an increase of \$11,000 in miscellaneous revenue.
