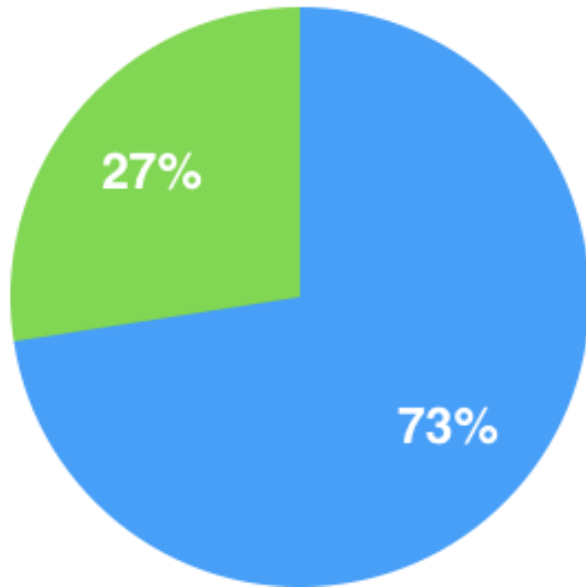

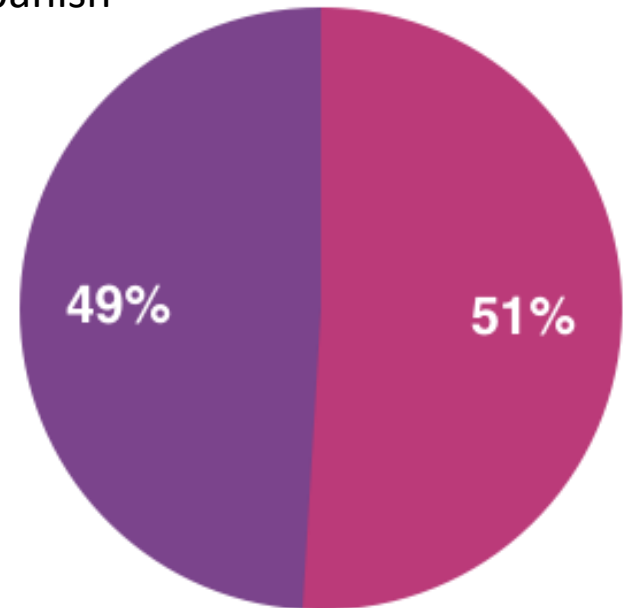

BY THE NUMBERS:

- 379** Total first gen, Latino student graduates
- 750+** Total students who have completed the program
- 100** High school student interns each year
- 52** First gen students each year

- 23** Percent went to community college or trade school

They are giving back to Ventura County

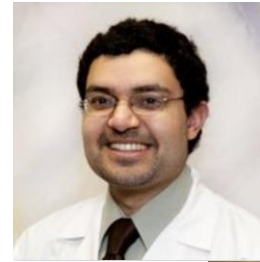
