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Discussion:

On February 27, 2019, the California Secretary of State (SOS) announced the deadline for counties to retire their old voting systems and to implement new systems that meet SOS certification standards in time for the March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election.

State grant funding has been made available to the County to purchase federal/State-compliant voting equipment beginning in FY 2018-19 to replace outmoded voting systems. This new voting equipment includes: all tabulation equipment, accessible equipment, election management system software and hardware, electronic poll books, and ballot on demand printers. This grant award funds the one-time purchase of all necessary hardware, software, and peripherals, including the first-year cost for software licenses.

The attached Standard Agreement Number 18G30156 will require the County to match funds for eligible expenditures for up to \$3,008,000 on a dollar-for-dollar basis. (Assembly Bill No. 1824, [Stats. 2018, ch. 38, § 1]).
