

RESOLUTION NO. 19-18

**DIRECTING PREPARATION OF THE ENGINEER'S REPORT  
FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE ASSESSMENTS FOR THE  
OAK VIEW SCHOOL PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE DISTRICT  
OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA**

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of the County of Ventura, State of California, as follows:

1. On July 23, 2002, this Board ordered the formation of and levied the first assessment within the Oak View School Preservation and Maintenance District (the "Assessment District") pursuant to the provisions of Article XIID of the California Constitution, and the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (the "Act"), Part 2 of Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500 thereof).
2. The purpose of the Assessment District shall be to acquire, install, maintain, and service those improvements described in Section 3 below.
3. It is proposed that the Oak View School Preservation and Maintenance District undertake the following improvements: acquisition, installation, maintenance and servicing of public facilities, including but not limited to, Oak View School site, facilities and improvements, playing fields, playground equipment, hard court surfaces, buildings, facilities, irrigation and sprinkler systems, landscaping, turf facilities, as applicable, for property owned, maintained or acquired by the County of Ventura. "Installation" means the construction or reconstruction of recreational improvements, buildings and facilities, including, but not limited to, land preparation (such as grading, leveling, cutting and filling), sod, landscaping, irrigation systems, sidewalks and drainage, lights, playground equipment, play courts, recreational facilities, public facilities and public restrooms, as well as debt service, issuance costs and other expenses associated with the issuance and administration of bonds for the improvements. "Maintenance" means the furnishing of services and materials for the ordinary and usual maintenance, operation and servicing of said improvements, including repair, removal, or

replacement of all or part of any improvement; providing for the life, growth, health and beauty of landscaping, including cultivation, irrigation, trimming, spraying, fertilizing, or treating for disease or injury; the removal of trimmings, rubbish, debris, and other solid waste, and the cleaning, sandblasting, and painting of walls and other improvements to remove or cover graffiti. "Servicing" means the furnishing of electric current, or energy, gas or other illuminating agent for any public lighting facilities or for the lighting or operation of any other improvements; or water for the irrigation of any landscaping, the operation of any fountains, or the maintenance of any other improvements.

4. SCI Consulting Group is hereby designated as Engineer of Work for purposes of these proceedings and is hereby ordered to prepare an Engineer's Report in accordance with Article 4 of Chapter 1 of the Act and Article XIID of the California Constitution. Upon completion, the Engineer shall file the Engineer's Report with the County for submission to the Board.

**PASSED AND ADOPTED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura, on a motion of Supervisor LONG, seconded by Supervisor Parks, and duly carried, the Board hereby adopts the foregoing resolution on the 12th day of March, 2019.
