TCM revenue has been included in FY15-16 adopted budget. This Board letter does not have any financial impact for Public Health.

Discussion:

The County's Targeted Case Management (TCM) program is a comprehensive case management service that assists clients within a specified target population to gain access to needed medical, social, educational and other services. The TCM program is reimbursed by the State for Medi-Cal clients that receive our service. The Gold Coast Health Plan (GCHP) and TCM program assist the same clients with different services. California's "Bridge to Reform", Section 1115 Medicald Demonstration Waiver and the related Medi-Cal managed care expansion require Medi-Cal beneficiaries' health plans to be responsible for broader care coordination and referral of resources for client social support issues.

In order to implement a collaborative approach between the TCM program and GCHP and to offer the broadest care possible to clients/members, the County is required to enter into a MOU with GCHP. This MOU will define protocols to follow in order to avoid duplication of services and activities. These protocols will serve as the basis for the coordination of care and non – duplication of services.
