

Resolution of The Board of Supervisors of Ventura County **PROCLAIMING** OCTOBER 2015 ENERGY AWARENESS MONTH

Whereas, the United States Department of Energy has designated October as National Energy Awareness Month to underscore how central energy is to our national prosperity, security, and environmental well-being; and

WHEREAS, THE PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION OF ENERGY AFFECTS OUR EVERYDAY ACTIVITIES AND NATURAL RESOURCES WHILE OFFERING EMPLOYMENT AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES THAT CONTRIBUTE TO A SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY; AND

Whereas, investments in energy efficiency and reducing energy usage helps to build a better future for residents, businesses and local governments. It is equally important to recognize the valuable contributions of residents, businesses and local governments in advancing energy innovation and efficiency; and
